



- According to police, the protesters had stockpiled homemade explosives, firecrackers and wooden boards inside the mosque, with the intention of attacking thousands of Jewish worshipers gathered below for prayers at the Western Wall on Tisha B'Av, a fast and day of mourning that commemorates the destruction of the first and second Jewish Temples.



PA - Peace Partner?



On Tisha B'Av, Jews mourn the destruction of the first and second Temples in Jerusalem (586 BCE and 70 CE). However, the Palestinian Authority denies that there ever was a Temple, consistently referring to Solomon's Temple as "the alleged Temple." Moreover, the PA also teaches its people that there was never a Jewish history in Jerusalem.

The Palestinian Authority claims persistently that Israel is "Judaizing" Jerusalem, as Palestinian Media Watch has documented. Israel is said to:

- falsify historical artifacts in order to prove a "false" Jewish history in Jerusalem
- destroy Palestinian and Islamic relics and signs of an Arab presence in the city
- plot to take over and <u>destroy the Al-Aqsa Mosque</u> in order to rebuild the "alleged Temple"in its stead

Palestinian Media Watch has prepared a comprehensive report on Palestinian Authority education. Two State Solution

- The EU said it will explore setting up a new international format to breathe life back into the stalled peace process between Israel and the Palestinians. EU foreign affairs chief Federica Mogherini, fresh from her role in the Iran nuclear deal, said she was working on an idea for an "international support group."
- "We have invested a lot as the EU" in trying to revive the moribund Middle East peace process. "The idea of an international support group is one that we will explore in coming weeks.
- Mogherini, a former Italian foreign minister, said the torturous but ultimately successful Iran talks showed that even the toughest problems could be resolved through diplomacy.





Unbelievable



- U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry said in an interview broadcast on Tuesday he was disturbed by anti-U.S. hostility voiced by Iran's top leader after last week's nuclear deal.
- Kerry said a speech by Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei on Saturday vowing to defy American policies in the region despite the deal with world powers was "very troubling."
- "I don't know how to interpret it at this point in time, except to take it at face value," Kerry said in an interview on Al Arabiya. "But I do know that often comments are made publicly and things can evolve that are different. If it is the policy, its very disturbing, its very troubling, and well have to wait and see.

Kerry's Latest Threat



"I fear that what could happen is that, if Congress were to overturn it, our friends in Israel could actually wind up being more isolated. And more blamed. And we would lose Europe and China and Russia with respect to whatever military action we might have to take. Because we will have turned our backs on a very legitimate program that allows us to put their program to the test over the next few years," Kerry told an audience at the Council of Foreign Relations in New York.
