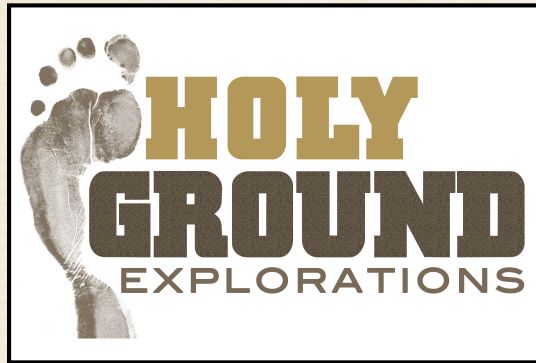

Headlines

- * Looking to reduce tensions on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem, U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry announced Saturday that Israel and Jordan had agreed on steps, including round-the-clock video monitoring, to try to bring the recent unrest to an end.
- * No common ground between PM and Abbas, and thus no prospect of end to violence. The PA has a long list of demands for Israel and believes Netanyahu will meet at least some of them; he probably will not.

We do not ask for your assistance in dealing with this terror and we do not seek your pity!


We demand for you to STOP justifying false claims made by FAKE people!

ISIS

- ❖ The Islamic State group on Friday published a video threatening Israel in Hebrew.
- ❖ In the video a masked man holding a weapon speaking fluent Hebrew warns Israelis, saying, "The true war hasn't yet started, what you've experienced until now is a child's war compared to what will happen soon. We promise you that not a single Jew will be left in the entire country."
- ❖ The speaker continues: "Look how you responded to a few car attacks and stabbings -- you fell on your heads, you shot anyone who drove fast and anyone with something in their hand."
- ❖ "Think what will happen to you when soon tens of thousands from all over the world will come to slaughter you and throw you in the trash."
- ❖ "We aren't just full of hot air -- we are closing in on you from every direction, from Sinai and from Damascus and more. The account between us is getting longer and longer. The account will be closed soon."



PA Demands full Muslim Oversight over Jewish Visitors to Temple Mount



- ❖ The Palestinian Authority has warned Israel that it will soon halt security coordination with the IDF in the West Bank unless the Muslim authorities on the Temple Mount are given full administrative control over Jewish groups visiting the holy site, PA officials told The Times of Israel on Thursday.
- ❖ The PA is also demanding that Israel take action to stop what it claims is escalated violence against Palestinians by settlers in the West Bank.



Hamas & the West Bank

Hamas looks to leverage wave of anti-Israel terrorism

Hamas views the current wave of Palestinian terrorism sweeping over Israel as an opportunity not to be missed, hoping it will turn into a mass uprising that will undermine the Palestinian Authority's control of the West Bank.

- ❖ On Thursday morning, a Palestinian teenager stabbed a soldier in the Gush Etzion settlement bloc south of Jerusalem; a day later, two 20-year-olds stabbed an Israeli man after unsuccessfully attempting to board a school bus full of children in the central city of Beit Shemesh.
- ❖ The latter two, after being shot by security forces, were both discovered to be wearing t-shirts reading "Izz ad-Din al-Qassam" – the name of Hamas's armed wing. All three attackers were from the Hebron-area village of Surif, and two of them – one in each incident – were named Ghanimat.
