

* 'ISIS bomb caused Russian plane crash in Sinai'

British and U.S. officials say they have information suggesting Russian jetliner that crashed in Egypt on Saturday was brought down by bomb planted on board by Islamic State group's Sinai affiliate

- * **Blood libel** After Palestinian U.N. envoy claims Israel harvested organs from Palestinians killed by its forces, Israel demands U.N. condemn the lie. "This blood libel by the Palestinian representative exposes his anti-Semitic motives," says Ambassador Danny Danon.






Gush Katif

Hamas Fired Rockets from Gush Katif

Hamas fired two rockets into the Mediterranean Sea, as part of its ongoing missile tests meant to advance its domestic rocket arsenal ahead of its next terror war against Israel. The rockets were fired from the ruins of Gush Katif, the group of Jewish communities from which 8,500 Jews were forcibly removed by the Israeli government during the controversial 2005 Disengagement Plan!





The Real Problem


- * "The truth is that the reason that we don't have peace yet with the Palestinians is not because of the settlements or a territorial dispute, the territories that were won in our defensive war of 1967," Netanyahu said. "Israelis and Palestinians had a conflict for half a century, almost 50 years, before Israel captured any of those territories or built even a single one of those settlements. And afterwards, we left part of that territory, Gaza. Left it to the very last centimeter or inch. Stripped out the settlements, went to the '67 boundaries, uprooted all the people who were there, disinterred people from their graves. What did we get? Peace? We got rockets.
- The truth is that the reason that there isn't peace between Israelis and Palestinians is the persistent Palestinian refusal to recognize the Jewish state in any boundary. That's the truth. If you recognize the problem, you'll be able to get to its solution.





Interesting Times

- Have you ever noticed that it is the Cave of Machpelah, the Tomb of Joseph in Nablus, and the Temple Mount in Jerusalem that are the most disputed pieces of land in Israel today?
- The answer is simple. It is these three pieces of land that are not only belong to the Jewish people by Divine right, but they were individually purchased, as well. Abraham purchased Hebron, Jacob purchased Nablus, and David purchased Jerusalem. Our enemies just can't stand legitimacy and they can't stand truth. This is why it is these three places in Israel that are subject to the most troubles, tension, and violence because our legitimacy over these places is even greater than our legitimacy over anywhere else in the Land.
- Ultimately our claim to the Land of Israel is not due to any contracts or declarations - it is due to the Almighty God who created the world and decided for Himself which parts of it He wants to give to whom.





BDS

- The European Union (EU) is due to publish specific guidelines related to labeling Israeli products from areas liberated during the 1967 Six Day War, when Israel fought against the surrounding Arab countries seeking to eliminate the Jewish state. Such action encourages BDS, which many consider to be a modern form of anti-Semitism.
- "I harshly oppose this harmful and superfluous move. It serves only one purpose, the continuation of hate and conflict in the area. Labeling products is a violent act of extremists who want to worsen the situation here even more, and the EU is falling in the trap that they have set," Herzog said, following a meeting in which he discussed the matter with British Ambassador to Israel David Quarrey.
