

* US Secretary of State John Kerry will visit the Middle East from Sunday to Tuesday, in a trip that will take him to Israel for the first time since the summer of 2014. Kerry will travel to Abu Dhabi, Tel Aviv, Jerusalem, and Ramallah, State Department spokesman John Kirby said in a statement Saturday, with Israeli-Palestinian violence, Syria and the Islamic State group all on the agenda. New peace talks not on agenda during Kerry visit to Israel. State Department says the visit will be an effort to 'reduce tensions.'

* Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas on Monday repeated two of his accusations against Israel that have drawn a furious response over the past few months – that the Jewish state is seeking to alter the status quo on the Temple Mount in Jerusalem and that it is carrying out “extrajudicial killings” of those Palestinians perpetrating terror attacks against Israelis.

* Stabbings, Car Rammings, Demonic Incitement continue within Israel and trouble brews with massive terrorist threats outside of Israel by ISIS. Turkey shoots down Russian plane and troops on the ground attempt to shoot the parachuting pilots.



* PA Ambulance Doesn't Help Dying Jews - Israel's UN ambassador, Danny Danon, wrote to UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon, demanding a condemnation of the Palestinian Red Crescent, following the revelation that the organization's ambulance was at the scene of the shooting attack near Chevron but the paramedics did not treat the wounded Israelis. This is a flagrant violation of international law!

* GAZA - "The current period is relatively quiet, the quietest in the past 15 years, because Hamas understands that if it goes on or takes part in the recent terrorist activity in Judea and Samaria, it will pay a heavy price," former GOC Southern Command Maj. Gen. Sami Turgeman said Tuesday at a panel titled "A Year Since Operation Protective Edge."



One Year Ago

Celebrating "the first anniversary" of the Har Nof synagogue massacre, the independent Palestinian news agency *Wattan* dedicated a full article to praising the two terrorists who with guns and butcher's knives slaughtered 5 Israeli worshippers, and killed a policeman last year. The article referred to the horrific killings as "the heroic operation" and an "epos written by the heroes." Terrorists who butchered 5 rabbis in synagogue and killed policeman"exemplified the meaning of heroism for the homeland... - ❖ On 19 November 2015, a Palestinian gunman opened fire on a line of traffic near Alon Shvut in the West Bank and continued to fire as he drove the car towards Gush Etzion Junction where he lost control of the vehicle, which then crashed into another vehicle. He killed 3 people, and wounded 5.
- ❖ "At this time, we would like to honor Ezra Schwartz and hundreds of victims like him with a moment of silence."
- ❖ Patriots owner Robert Kraft has been an active supporter of Israel. He took a group of NFL Hall of Famers on a trip to Israel over the summer.
- ❖ After his bar mitzvah five years ago, Schwartz donated gift money he had received to United Hatzalah, an Israeli emergency medical services organization. The money was used to buy a motorcycle ambulance, known as an "ambucycle," which is still in use by the organization.

US Won't Recognize Israeli Sovereignty in Golan


Washington rejects Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's suggestion to U.S. President Barack Obama at the White House to discuss the possibility of U.S. recognition of Israeli rule over the Golan Heights.

(The Golan Heights were part of Palestinian Mandate, which was designated to formation of Jewish state - Eretz-Israel. It was illegally ceded to Syria in 1922. Israel recaptured it in a defensive war. By all international legal standards it is integral part of Israel!)
