

# Gaza Prepares for War

- After quite a few attempts at concealment and denial, Hamas's military wing, the Izz ad-Din al-Qassam Brigades, on Thursday released the names of "the seven heroes, men of Allah" who were killed earlier in the week in the collapse of an attack tunnel in the Tufah neighborhood in the northeastern part of Gaza City, only a few hundred yards from the Israeli border.
- During the funeral procession for Hamas members who were killed when the tunnel they were working in caved in, the roof of a nearby building collapsed under the excessive weight of some overly-zealous onlookers.
- Perhaps there's a message here that the Palestinians aren't getting.









- 25% of Israeli Jews fear another Holocaust, poll shows
- World Zionist Organization poll also shows that Israelis worry about their safety when traveling abroad, and 65% say they play down their Israeli/ Jewish identity. Two-thirds say European governments not effective in fighting anti-Semitism.
- Another worrying number also emerged from the poll: 25% of Israelis believe there is reason to fear that another Holocaust will be perpetrated against the Jewish people, and 24% believe there is a chance that the State of Israel will cease to exist.

# The Facebook Nation

- "The most dangerous nation in the Middle East acting against Israel is the state of Facebook," said the former head of the IDF Military Intelligence Directorate on Friday, according to Hebrew news website nrg.
- "It has a lot more power than anybody who's operating an armed force," said Amos Yadlin, who is also the executive director at the Tel Aviv-based Institute for National Security Studies. "Unlike before, there's no longer an existential military threat facing Israel. Rather, it's a strategic threat."
- Yadlin said there was not enough being invested in confronting the scourge of anti-Israel material, including antisemitism and incitement to violence against Israelis, circulating on social media.
- Public Security and Information Minister Gilad Erdan, meanwhile, said the government had set aside NIS 100 million to "develop solutions to the battle on social media,"





### Remember: Land for Peace

- "It's appropriate that the Knesset, which made the decision [to evacuate], know how to remember it and remind visitors of the communities of Gush Katif and northern Samaria," Edelstein said.
- The statue, created by sculptor Aharon Shabo, is a miniature copy in bronze of a statue erected at the Gush Katif Center in Nitzan, and depicts a palm tree growing between two halves of a Star of David.
- The statue symbolizes the crisis of the communities being uprooted and the ability to grow anew out of the schism. The side of the statue is inscribed with the names of the 21 Gush Katif and northern Samaria communities that were evacuated.
