On Wednesday, **Obama** said: "An attack on one faith is an attack on all our faiths." He also criticized the media and Hollywood, which he said portray Muslims in a narrow way. "Our television shows should have Muslim characters that are unrelated to national security," he said.

The Indiana House of Representatives this week passed new legislation that targets businesses or other entities engaging in the anti-Israel Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) movement, marking the latest victory in the fight against BDS on the US state level. House Bill 1378, which was introduced by Indiana House Speaker Brian Bosma and passed unanimously by the legislature on Jan. 25, requires "the public retirement system to divest from businesses that engage in action or inaction to boycott, divest from, or sanction Israel."




Obamas Mosque Speech

To Simple?

- Israel has given a lot of stuff back. They gave Gaza back. How is that working out? They have everything launching into Israel," Kasich said. "I don't know how you get a two-state solution when people are walking into your country and stabbing people.

- * "The students in east Jerusalem are influenced through social media and are acting on emotions," Lara Mubariki, the head of education for Arab students in the city, told nrg. She said the school system was bringing in religious leaders from northern Israel to teach about coexistence, tolerance and the value of life since many of the stabbing attacks over the past several months have ended in both victim and perpetrator casualties as well as about the need to acquire an education in order to achieve a better life.
