The Internet video-sharing portal YouTube removed content from an account belonging to Palestinian Media Watch (PMW) on **Sunday, March 6**, after claiming that PMW had violated YouTube's terms of service.

PMW, which monitors and exposes incitement in Palestinian media, last posted a video to YouTube on Thursday March 3. The video showed a Palestinian girl reading a poem on official Palestinian Authority (PA) television calling for a "war that will smash the oppressor and destroy the Zionist soul."

Hemes Tunnels

- Members of Hamas's Izzedine al-Qassam Brigades are starting to refuse orders to dig underground tunnels, which have mysteriously collapsed one after the other in recent months as the Palestinian terror group attempts to rebuild the network of cross-border attack tunnels that Israel destroyed during Operation Protective Edge in 2014.
- In an open field east of Khan Younis on Thursday, a tunnel being dug by the al-Qassam Brigades collapsed, killing 31-yearold Muhammad Musa al Astal, Hamas said. Palestinian media quoted senior Hamas officials who confirmed that an additional five tunnel diggers were missing.

Thursday's tunnel collapse was the seventh such incident in recent months.





"LIKE" ISIS

White House Press Secretary Josh Earnest answered a question on counterterrorism by claiming that the administration was hard at work developing "some pretty sophisticated social media strategy." But it appears now that the administration is contemplating an even less confrontational approach - a widespread effort to "Like" ISIS.

Sandberg was very vague on how the "Like attack" would affect ISIS, and her implication that neo-Nazis and Islamists will react similarly to these social media stories betrays a shallow understanding of Islamism.

New York Senator and Secretary of State, perpetual presidential candidate, and frequent advocate of the oxymoronic "soft power," appears to be convinced of the thinking behind the Facebook plan. The former first lady often claims that effective foreign policy is simply a matter of rejecting what she calls "the clash of civilizations." In place of the "hard power" implied in "clash," she has lately taken to extolling the powers of love and kindness.

American interests will be far better served if the policymakers in the next administration abandon the delusion that our enemies can be swayed, even defeated, by a display of our love. John Lennon was wrong: you need more than love.





Chemical Weapons

- Defense Minister Moshe Ya'alon said that Syrian government forces have used chemical weapons against civilians despite the ceasefire - brokered by Russia and the U.S. - aimed at bringing an end to the civil war in that country that began in 2011 and, according to the Syrian Center for Policy Research, has claimed close to 500,000 lives.
- "The Syrians used military grade chemical weapons and lately have been using materials, chlorine, against civilians, including in these very days, after the supposed ceasefire, dropping barrels of chlorine on civilians," Ya'alon said at an event organized by the New Tech military and aviation group in Airport City, near Tel Aviv.
- Ya'alon, said Israel was "very concerned" about the growing Iranian presence and influence in Syria. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has said that any peaceful resolution in Syria must guarantee Israel's security needs, ensuring that Iran does not establish a terror front against Israel from the Syrian Golan Heights.





Coming Soon

- STAY TUNED! The US administration is reportedly weighing what would be a highly controversial move to back a United Nations resolution outlining the principles of a two-state Israeli-Palestinian peace deal in a fresh peace push.
- The White House is working on plans to force Israel, against its national interests, to accept a diplomatic resolution with the Palestinians before President Barack Obama leaves office, including a possible United Nations Security Council (UNSC) resolution that would outline a deal between the Israelis and Palestinians and which includes the partition of Jerusalem, Israel's capital.
- One scenario has the US pushing Israel to recognize east Jerusalem as the capital of a Palestinian state. The Palestinians would in turn be asked to recognize Israel as a Jewish state and end claims on a right of return for the so-called Palestinian refugees, a fundamental step they have refused to take through decades of negotiations. Under that scenario, the administration also would recommend the establishment of two states based on the 1949 armistice line, leaving Israel with slim and indefensible borders.
