Headlines

IRAN - Last week, Iran test-fired two ballistic missiles at a target some 1,400 kilometers (870 miles) away, with the phrase "Israel must be wiped out" written on them, Iran's semiofficial Fars News Agency reported on Wednesday.

BOSTON - Catholic high school students chanted, "You killed Jesus" at a basketball game against a predominantly Jewish high school in a Boston suburb on Friday night.

FRANCE - Two black swastikas were drawn on a relief shaped like the Tablets of Testimony that adorns the synagogue's entrance. "Screw the Jews" and another profanity were written on an exterior wall.



HAMAS TUNNELS - Report: Israel builds underground defense system to tackle tunnels. Foreign Policy magazine reports Israel digging its own network of underground tunnels near Gaza, equipped with seismic sensors to monitor underground vibrations

KNIFINGS - Chief rabbi urges Israelis to kill terrorists bearing knives. Chief Sephardi Rabbi Yitzhak Yosef says at weekly sermon: As soon as terrorists realize that if they wield a knife they won't stay alive -- it will deter them. It is a mitzvah to kill them • Don't heed any IDF chief of staff who says otherwise, he warns.



Gaza Rockets - Sderot



- ❖ Late Friday night, at about 10:30, sirens sounded in the southern city of Sderot after terrorists launched four rockets at Israel from the Gaza Strip. The rockets landed in open areas, and there were no injuries. No terror organization claimed responsibility. Israel places full responsibility on attacks from Gaza on Hamas, which rules the Strip. In response to Friday night's rocket fire, the Israeli Air Force targeted four Hamas sites in northern Gaza. Hamas claims that two children were killed in the retaliatory strikes.



Iranian Rockets

- ❖ A missile launched from the Alborz mountains in Iran on March 9, 2016, reportedly inscribed in Hebrew, "Israel must be wiped out." (Fars News)
- ❖ "The test firing of ballistic missiles constitutes a gross violation of UNSC Resolution 2231, which endorsed the nuclear agreement between Iran and the P5+1," Danon wrote. "Iran continues to disregard its obligations to UN resolutions. This latest provocation makes it clear that the 'smile campaign' of the current regime is nothing more than a smokescreen to disguise the real intentions of the ayatollah regime."
- ❖ The ambassador also highlighted the fact that the Iranians had written "Israel must be wiped off the face of the earth" in Hebrew on the side of missiles, and that a senior member of the Revolutionary Guards had warned that Iran had missiles able to reach any point in Israel.
