Headlines

Temple Mount

Jordan won't Expose Palestinian Thuggery

Jordan's prime minister said his government has decided to call off a plan to install surveillance cameras at the Temple Mount. The decision came just days before the Jewish holiday of Passover - a time of increased violet activity at the site. In a deal brokered by US Secretary of State John Kerry, Jordan offered to install the cameras last fall. (Most political deals with Israel are not honoured by Arabs!)





PA - Peace Partner

Mahmoud Abbas' Fatah movement is promoting its student movement Shabiba's election campaign at Birzeit University by posting the above poster on its official Facebook page.

The poster shows a knife dripping with blood, shaped as the PA's map of "Palestine" that includes the PA areas as well as all of Israel. The entire map is painted in the colors of the Palestinian flag, implying Palestinian political sovereignty over Israel.

Text on the poster says: "Plant it [the knife] in the heart of your enemy" [Official Fatah Facebook page, April 26, 2016]

Palestinian Media Watch has shown that both Fatah and the PA in statements and visual expressions reject the idea of a two-state solution, and instead present a future with only one state of "Palestine," completely erasing Israel.



Why No Peace in the ME

 Young Palestinian children participating in a festival in the Gaza Strip this week wore military fatigues, and brandished toy knives and machine guns as they performed a play simulating violence against Israelis.

- The event was broadcast on a Hamas television channel dedicated to culture, available in Gaza and the West Bank, according to Channel 2 news.
- One short clip of the play aired on Tuesday shows a young girl armed with a knife attempting to free a Palestinian prisoner from Israeli jail by stabbing the guards. She is shot and falls to the ground amid cries and screams from the audience. Other little girls then approach and cry over her "body."
- "Do not be angry with her," a voice on the loudspeaker says. "She is your blood, your flesh and your honor."
- "When Palestinians send their kids to act in this school play no wonder their kids commit attacks when they're older" Gendelman tweeted.


Priestly Blessing

Thousands of Jews gathered at the Western Wall in Jerusalem on Monday to attend a mass prayer for the holiday of Passover.

The crowd of men, women and children took part in the special Birkat Hakohanim prayer, or the "Priestly Blessing," which draws Jewish worshippers from across Israel and around the world. The blessing is held twice a year, during the holidays of Passover and Sukkot. Kohanim, or priests, lead the communal prayers by chanting three consecutive verses of the Torah one word at a time, in a special song reputedly dating back to the Temple era.

The text of the Priestly Blessing recited by the Kohanim, which appears verbatim in the Torah, is:

May the LORD bless you and guard you -May the LORD make His face shed light upon you and be gracious unto you -May the LORD lift up His face unto you and give you peace -
