ISRAELI ISSUES

England - Al Quds


 As reported by The Algemeiner, the annual march has emerged as a festival of incitement against Israel. In previous years, the flags of Hezbollah, Hamas and ISIS have been flown, with rally organizers failing to issue condemnations of open displays of support for terror. In the UK, only Hezbollah's military branch – which shares the same flag as its political branch is classified as a terrorist organization.





LOVABLE IRAN

- Iranian demonstrators burn statue of Liberty with a Star of David during a rally marking al-Quds Day in Tehran.
- Iranians are staging anti-Israel rallies across the country, with protesters condemning the Israeli "occupation" of Palestinian territories and chanting "Death to Israel" and "Death to America." Tens of thousands of people are marching in the capital, Tehran, as part of the Al-Quds day rallies held each year on the last Friday of Ramadan.
- Tens of thousands of missiles located across the Middle East are ready to strike Israel at a moment's notice, Lieutenant Commander of the Islamic Revolutionary Guards Corp (IRGC) Brigadier General Hossein Salami threatened on Friday.













Sderot

- Life has returned to normal in the southern Israeli town of Sderot following Friday night's rocket attack in which a child care center in the town was seriously damaged. Three people who were nearby when the rocket exploded in the center were treated for symptoms of shock. The center was empty at the time of the attack.
- Over the weekend, municipal social workers visited residents of the area near where the rocket hit.
- Sderot Mayor Alon Davidi called his town's quick return to normalcy a "triumph of spirit." The child care center will return to full operations within a few days, the mayor said. Already on Sunday, a kindergarten graduation ceremony was held at the center.
- "Terrorism will not overcome the civil resilience of Sderot residents," Davidi said at the ceremony. "The children here enjoying themselves alongside their parents are the guarantee that terrorism will not dictate our lives."





Merry Remeden


- Suicide bombers struck three cities across Saudi Arabia on Monday, killing at least four security officers in an apparently coordinated campaign of attacks as Saudis prepared to break their fast on the penultimate day of the holy month of Ramadan.
- The explosions targeting U.S. diplomats, Shiite worshippers and a security headquarters at a mosque in the holy city of Medina followed days of mass killings claimed by the Islamic State group in Turkey, Bangladesh and Iraq. The attacks all seem to have been timed to coincide with the approach of Eid al-Fitr, the holiday that celebrates the end of the Islamic holy month.
