Israeli Issues



- Likud MK Avi Dichter: We will respect the sanctity of the mosque in Jerusalem and will stand up for our rights on the Temple Mount."




Temple Mount

Praising Jewish G-d not Allowed on the Temple Mount

Jerusalem Police detained seven Jewish visitors to the Temple Mount on Sunday, the 9th of Av, for "breaking the rules" set by the Waqf, the Jordanian charity that runs the compound. They said Shema Israel" and "Hashem Hu Ha'Elohim." (HaShem, He is G-d)

Another Jewish visitor was arrested for tearing his shirt, a Jewish expression of mourning. As the Jews were being arrested, dozens of Muslims started ganging up on the cops and the visitors, screaming that same incriminating call of faith in God, except in the approved Arabic. (Arabs were not arrested!)





Shocking New US Stance

- The Obama Administration no longer claims that the PA is working "to control and eliminate" expressions of anti-Semitism in its media outlets. Officials dropped an assertion made in previous years that the PA acted to "prevent preaching" of "sermons with intolerant or anti-Semitic messages."
- For years, Israeli leaders have accused the PA and its leader, Mahmoud Abbas, of inciting violence and anti-Semitism. Last year amid increasing terror attacks on Israelis, Abbas called for Jerusalem's holy sites to be cleansed of Jews.
- With the US on the record calling the PA activity anti-Semitism, it could be a step closer to a change in US policy towards the PA, which is overdue,.



Obama - Last Ditch Effort?

- ❖ Israeli diplomats, the prime minister's office and foreign ministry officials are reportedly preparing for the possibility that President Barack Obama will launch a last-ditch diplomatic initiative during the interim period between the elections in November and the swearing-in of the elected president in January.
- Israel Radio in a Wednesday report quoted an Israeli source that said that the initiative includes a proposal submitted to the UN Security Council (UNSC) on the two-state solution, based on the pre-1967 lines, which could later serve as an opening position for future negotiations between Israel and the Palestinians.





Hezbollah & Social Media


Using social media, the Shiite terrorist group has been trying to recruit Palestinians and Israeli Arabs to form a terrorist network against Israel, says Shin Bet security agency.

"Hezbollah has recently prioritized instigating terrorist attacks, which it does from afar so to conceal its involvement. It is doing this, among other ways, by rousing incitement and inducing the Palestinian population to carry out terrorist attacks, in return for financial payments."

Meanwhile, in response to Hezbollah's recent recruitment efforts, Israeli Ambassador to the U.N. Danny Danon called on the international organization to formally recognize Hezbollah as a terrorist organization.

"The international community must condemn Hezbollah's attempts to harm innocent Israeli civilians, and the Security Council must finally designate Hezbollah a terrorist organization," Danon said in a statement.

"Hezbollah needs to know that any terrorist act against Israel will come at a very heavy price," he said.

Moses stated the central commandment of the Torah - the Shema - affirming the oneness of the LORD and our duty to love and serve Him with all our hearts. The people were warned to carefully transmit to the next generation the commandments of God - to teach them "diligently" to their children - and to place the commandments as "signs" on their hand and heads (tefillin), and to inscribe them upon the doorposts of their dwellings (mezuzah).

A person demonstrates his devotion to the Torah by what priority he gives it in the education of his children.
