TRUMP - MASADA

U.S. President Donald Trump's delegation was due to arrive in Israel on Friday to finalize the president's itinerary ahead of an official visit scheduled for May 22.

Trump is scheduled to visit the Western Wall in the Old City of Jerusalem, as well as Masada, a Roman-era fortress in the Judean Desert, during his 26-hour stopover. Trump reportedly plans to give an address at Masada -- a site that symbolizes the Jews' unwavering spirit in the face of adversity. American officials have described Trump's speech as "warm and sympathetic toward Israel and the Jewish nation, whose people never yield."





PA & TRUMP VISIT



US President Donald Trump will not pass by the grave of the late Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat during his visit to Israel and the West Bank later this month, despite reported efforts by the Palestinian Authority to bring him by the site. According to a report Monday, the PA sought to hold a ceremony welcoming Trump at the Muqata'a compound in Ramallah, to which he would have arrived by way of the adjacent mausoleum housing Arafat's remains. Citing an unnamed PA official, the report said that the Palestinians intended to keep Trump and his entourage in the dark as to the plan to lead him through the grave site.

PA President Mahmoud Abbas met with Russian President Vladimir Putin at the Sochi resort in Western Russia on Thursday, and said that solving the Israeli-Palestinian conflict will be "impossible" without the participation of Moscow in the peace process.


"It is impossible to solve the Palestinian issue without Russia's meaningful participation in the peace process. That is what we have been emphasizing at all international meetings," Abbas said in his meeting with Putin, according to the official Russian State news agency Tass. Putin said Russia "will continue to give its full support to the resumption of direct dialogue between Palestinians and Israelis."



TIME FOR TRUTH

"Bennett: We must tell Trump the 'truth' about peace process" by Ben Caspit: "I am the only

person in the government of Israel who ever made a business deal in general and a business deal in America in particular," said [Education Minister Naftali Bennett.] "I lived in the US for years. I know New York and the American business world... What I learned about dealmaking in America from this is to tell the truth, even if it is unpleasant. Don't bluff... and I am sure that Trump would be able to appreciate that. The truth is that there is no [feasible] deal. The maximum that we are willing to give and the minimum that they are willing to accept don't jive. As for saying that it's possible, creating hopes and then causing disappointments and, later, violence, I don't see who benefits from that. President Trump is talking about a deal? Let's talk about the real deal. The real deal is economic peace and expanded [Palestinian] autonomy... All the rest is an illusion, and it will be shattered." [Al-Monitor]



YOUNG ISRAELIS

A majority of young Israeli Jews between ages 15-24 define themselves as right-wing, and a growing number of them are religious, a study published Thursday said.

Sixty-seven percent of Jewish youth define themselves as right-wing (or center-right), while just 16% consider themselves to be leftwing in findings from a survey of Israeli youth by the Macro Center for Political Economics and the Friedrich Ebert Foundation, cited Thursday in a Yedioth Ahronoth report.

In a similar survey by the two organizations 19 years ago, 50% of respondents classified themselves as secular compared to 9% who referred to themselves as ultra-Orthodox. Those numbers moved to 40% and 15%, respectively, in this year's edition, demonstrating increased religious tendencies.



STIPENDS FOR TERROR

On March 8, 2016, American Taylor Force was murdered along the Tel Aviv beach. Bashar Masalha stabbed Force and wounded 12 others, including a pregnant woman. Sadly, Force was not the first, and will likely not be the last, American victim of Palestinian Arab terror.

More sadly, and shocking, your US tax dollars indirectly motivate, and fund, such acts of terror against Americans, Israelis and others. The PA also pays monthly stipends for families of "martyrs," terrorists killed while attempting to murder others, and "salaries" to terrorists that are caught and imprisoned. While its nonsense that poverty motivates terror since there's poverty worldwide, but none with the culture of murder and "martyrdom" like the PA, providing such a stipend for one to go on a murderous terror spree is certainly an added perk. It's like getting a bonus at work for a job well done.

Imprisoned terrorists' "salaries" can range from \$364 to \$3,120 a month, increasing with the length of the prison term. A stipend to the family of a married civilian "martyr" with two kids starts at about \$2500 a year. The PA cumulatively allocates more than \$303 million (in 2016) for this, representing about 7% of its annual budget.
