THE LATEST UN VOTE

The UN's cultural body on Tuesday passed the latest in a series of resolutions that denies Israeli claims to Jerusalem, in a move both forcefully condemned by Israel. The <u>resolution on "Occupied Palestine,"</u> which indicates that Israel has no legal or historical rights anywhere in Jerusalem, had been expected to pass, given the automatic anti-Israel majority in the 58-member body. The vote, which coincided with Israel's Independence Day, passed with 22 countries in favor, 23 abstentions, 10 opposed, and the representatives of three countries absent.

The resolution indicates rejection of the Jewish state's sovereignty in any part of Jerusalem. Israel is referred to throughout the document as the "occupying power" in Jerusalem, indicating that it has no legal or historical ties to any part of the city.







THE DEAL-MAKER?





President Donald Trump reiterated on Thursday his view that an Israeli-Palestinian peace agreement is an achievable goal for his administration.

"I want to see peace with Israel and the Palestinians," he <u>told Reuters in an interview</u>. "There's no reason there's not peace between Israel and the Palestinians – none whatsoever." Trump declined to answer a question from *Reuters* about whether he would recognize Jerusalem as Israel's capital, saying, "Ask me in a month on that."

After he was elected president last November, Trump <u>said</u> he would "love to be the one who made peace with Israel and the Palestinians," calling it "the ultimate deal." "As a deal-maker, I'd like to do...the deal that can't be made."

TRUMP & ABBAS



A spokesperson for the Trump administration said Wednesday that the US president expressed concern over the policy of paying terrorists and their families a monthly income dolled out by the Palestinian Authority president, Mahmoud Abbas.

Sean Spicer added that Trump told his Palestinian counterpart, who arrived at the White House for the first time Wednesday afternoon, that the Palestinian Authority must also cease incitement broadcasted on Palestinian television.

THE REAL MAHMOUD ABBAS

As international pressure is mounting on Mahmoud Abbas to stop payments to terrorists prisoners, it should be recognized that Mahmoud Abbas himself is personally responsible for the high salaries that terrorists receive. In 2010, Mahmoud Abbas amended the Palestinian Prisoners Law, dramatically raising salaries to terrorist prisoners. Prior to that, salaries ranged from 1000-4000 shekels a month; now they start at 1400 shekels and can reach as high as 12,000 shekels each month.

Not only is Abbas personally responsible for paying salaries to terrorists, by his own admission he is responsible for sending terrorists to kill Israelis. Abbas told official PA TV in 2005, right after the PA's five-year terror campaign (i.e., the second Intifada) had ended, that all the terrorist prisoners must be freed because they did not murder of their own volition but were sent to murder by the PA





A KINDER GENTLER HAMAS?

Hamas tries to rebrand itself as an Islamic national liberation movement, rather than a branch of the pan-Arab Muslim Brotherhood, which has been outlawed by Egypt. It also drops explicit language calling for Israel's destruction, though it retains the goal of eventually "liberating" all of "Palestine," which includes the entirety of Israel, and so this constitutes only a semantic change.

While the founding charter was filled with anti-Jewish references and anti-Semitic language, the new document stresses that Hamas bears no enmity toward Jews. It says its fight is with those who occupy "Palestinian lands."

Israel said the document aimed to deceive the world into believing that Hamas was becoming more moderate.

DAY 1: Overnight in Tel Aviv right on the Mediterranean Sea.






