#### **Will Russia Move Embassy to Jerusalem First?**

Jerusalem Affairs Minister tells Russian Ambassador Russia has a chance to become the first nation to move its embassy to Jerusalem. "I cannot help but hope that you and your country will take advantage of the half-year break that the president of the United States has unfortunately taken, and in the next six months, to win the competition between the two powers and beat the Americans to the punch."

#### **One Missile Makes a Difference**

A single mystery missile, which could have been fired from the ground or the air early <u>Wednesday</u> morning, June 7, wiped out the entire top Islamic State command on the Syrian Golan. All 16 officers of the 2,000-strong Khaled Ibn al Waleed army, the ISIS operations arm on the Syrian Golan, were present in the targeted building.

The Palestinian Authority on Wednesday blamed Israel for an energy crisis in Gaza, after Israel acceded to a request by Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas to slash the amount of power it transfers to the beleaguered Strip and defended the move by saying the matter was an internal Palestinian rift. Hamas could easily solve Gaza's electricity crisis, but prefers to finance tunnels and rockets

"Not one shred of information will be offered without a prisoner exchange deal that will see the release of our people held by the Zionist entity," Hamas official says after Red Cross asks for information on two slain soldiers and three civilian captives.

### TIMING FOR EMBASSY MOVE

In general, it is Trump's presentation of power that garners respect among many Palestinians and Arabs. The Arabs admire and respect such figures because they have been ruled for decades by ruthless tyrants and dictators such as Saddam Hussein. But the Arabs also respect leaders who keep their promises, even if they disagree with and oppose those promises.





# JERUSALEM, PALESTINE?

Aside from several postings for employment opportunities in "Occupied Palestinian territory," referring to locations in Judea and Samaria, most recently the UN posted an opening for a position in "Jerusalem, Palestine."

The United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS) posted a position on its website (see below) seeking a project manager for its Jerusalem office. The "duty station" designated for the job was "Jerusalem, Palestine (State of)."

Israel's Ambassador to the United Nations Danny Danon called on Under-Secretary-General Grete Faremo, the UNOPS executive director, to remove the job posting from the site and institute immediate reforms.

"It is unacceptable for UN resources to be used for anti-Israel activity and to attempt to change the facts on the ground," Danon stated.






## TERROR TUNNELS






