

FRIEDMAN COMMENTS

US Ambassador - Settlements Are Part of Israel.

David M. Friedman had strong words of support for Israel. "I think the settlements are part of Israel," he said. "I think that was always the expectation when UN Resolution 242 was adopted in 1967. "The idea was that Israel would be entitled to secure borders," he said. "The existing borders, the '1967 borders' were viewed by everybody as not secure, so Israel would retain a meaningful portion of the West Bank and it would return that which it didn't need for peace and security..." (Judea and Samaria is Jewish land! But it is good step in the right direction. Anti-Semites in State Dept distance themselves from his comments.)



MOSSAD - IRAN

The head of the Mossad intelligence service warned on Monday that Iran, through its proxies, is operating closer "than ever before" to Israel's borders with Lebanon and Syria, though he also said Israel was operating deep in enemy territory.

Spy chief Yossi Cohen said that in addition to arming the terrorist groups Hezbollah and Hamas, the Islamic Republic was working to develop its own nuclear capabilities with the goal of weaponizing them.

Cohen made his remarks at a ceremony in which six teams from the espionage service received a special commendation from Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu. Due to the sensitivity of the operations, the details of the teams' activities were kept secret.





NEW PA LEADERS?

Enemy Population Loves Terrorists as Leaders. According to the latest poll 67% of the public want Abbas to resign. Demand for Abbas' resignation stands at 60% in the PA and 80% in the Gaza Strip. If Abbas does not nominate himself in a new election, 35% prefer to see **Marwan Barghouti** replacing him, while 21% prefer **Ismail Haniyeh**.





NEW HAMAS LEADERS

Saleh al-Arouri, expelled from Qatar earlier this year, will serve under Ismail Haniyeh in the terror group's political bureau

Hamas on Thursday announced that top commander Saleh al-Arouri, who in recent years served as the terror group's head of West Bank operations, will be appointed as the organization's deputy political leader.

Arouri will thus serve under Ismail Haniyeh, who himself replaced Khaled Mashaal as the group's political bureau chief in May. He is believed to have since settled in Lebanon, and was publicly spotted in Beirut in August.

Defense Minister Avigdor Liberman has said Arouri continues to plan terror attacks against Israel and has been attempting "to boost the relationship between Hamas and Hezbollah" with Iranian support.

Israeli intelligence officials believe that Arouri helped plan the June 2014 kidnapping and murder of three Israeli teens – Gil-ad Shaar, Eyal Yifrach and Naftali Fraenkel – as well as numerous other attacks.





BIBI - PA / HAMAS

Netanyahu on the Palestinian Authority-Hamas reconciliation talks, at the start of a meeting of the **Tanach Study Circle** at the Prime Minister's Residence yesterday: "Whoever talks about peace needs to say, first of all, that it is necessary to recognize the State of Israel, the state of the Jewish People... We are not interested in a bogus reconciliation in which the Palestinian factions reconcile with each other at the expense of our existence. Therefore, we expect to see three things: One recognition of the State of Israel; two dismantling the military arm of Hamas; and three - severing the link with Iran, which calls for our destruction."





TRUMP COMMENTS

"Trump to UN Chief: Netanyahu Proving More Difficult Than Abbas in Peace Efforts" by Barak

Ravid: "In a meeting last month with **UN Secretary-General Antonio** Guterres, U.S. President Donald Trump termed Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu the harder side to convince in his efforts to broker an Israeli-Palestinian peace deal... "Trump said both leaders are problematic," said one Western diplomat who was briefed on the meeting. "But the general context was that from the two of them, Netanyahu is the bigger problem."





ABBAS' DOUBLE TALK

Palestinian Authority head Mahmoud Abbas' recent responses to terror attacks on Israelis continue a familiar pattern of "condemnations" in English, followed, sometimes on the same day, by praise for terrorists in Arabic statements to the press and constituents.

Most recently, Mahmoud Abbas followed up a condemnation with an inciting speech declaring, "Every drop of blood that has been spilled in Jerusalem is holy blood as long as it was for Allah. Every martyr will reach Paradise."

Unfortunately, the media chooses to focus only on the English language "condemnations," without covering the inflammatory and unrepentant rhetoric Palestinian leaders use when issuing statements in Arabic.
