

On Wednesday, the tenuous cease-fire collapsed when a Palestinian sniper shot and wounded an IDF officer near the Gaza border.

The incident took place in the early evening hours near the abandoned Kissufim border crossing, when Israeli troops trying to keep a group of Palestinian children away from the fence came under fire.

Prior to Wednesday's incident, it appeared that the brittle truce, brokered by Egyptian officials and U.N. Middle East envoy Nikolay Mladenov on Saturday, was largely holding. Wednesday's incident was the second time in less than a week that a Palestinian sniper was able to hit an Israeli soldier.







ULTIMATE DEAL WATCH – Bibi Netanyahu rejected the timing of a Russian proposal to host a summit between the Israeli Prime Minister and Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas in Moscow, Barak Ravid reported this morning. In their meeting in Jerusalem on Monday, Russian Foreign Minister Sergey Lavrov told Netanyahu that Abbas has already agreed to meet. Netanyahu did not outright reject the offer to meet with Abbas, but maintained that it could not take place before the Trump peace plan rollout.



TBUNDS DEACEDUAN





Ambassador Nikki Haley, Jared Kushner, Jason Greenblatt and Ambassador David Friedman write... "The peace proposal we will make will be similarly realistic, recognizing the legitimate needs of both Israel and the Palestinians as well as the interests of the broader region. No one will be fully pleased with our proposal, but that's the way it must be if real peace is to be achieved. Peace can only succeed if it is based on realities." [CNN]

The Trump administration's long-awaited plan for Israeli-Palestinian peace is "dead upon arrival," the Palestinian U.N. ambassador said Tuesday. Ambassador Riyad Mansour reiterated the Palestinian leadership's stance that with President Donald Trump's unilateral recognition of Jerusalem as Israel's capital on Dec. 6, the United States "lost the qualification to be the only party to supervise the political process."

ISADETO HAMAS





U.S. President Donald Trump's senior Mideast advisers are proposing to give Hamas billions of dollars if it will recognize Israel and suspend terrorist attacks. Bad idea. Getting rid of Hamas--not bribing it--is the only hope for peace in Gaza.

In a Washington Post op-ed on July 20, presidential advisers Jared Kushner and Jason Greenblatt, together with U.S. Ambassador to Israel David Friedman, noted that despite the international community's gifts of "billions of dollars" to Gaza in the past 70 years, unemployment is at 49 percent, and 53 percent of Gazans live below the poverty line.



CHIPPEN'S GAMES

IDF Staff Sgt. Aviv Levi, killed Friday by Palestinian sniper fire on the Gaza border, was hit by an armorpiercing bullet fired from an Iranian-manufactured rifle. That was the conclusion of a preliminary IDF investigation into the circumstances of Levi's death, according to a *Hadashot* TV report Sunday.

"It is not easy to eulogize my son. It's not natural," said his father, Yaakov. "You were a ray of shining and smiling sun for us. We loved seeing every moment of you becoming the man that we knew. You were the salt of the earth and paid the ultimate price for your outstanding service. "You never avoided any mission, however large or small. You guarded and protected your friends. We are not parting here. You will be with us forever," the father said in the presence of hundreds of soldiers donning the purple Givati beret.







BREAKING – Israel shot down a Syrian fighter jet that entered Israeli airspace earlier today. The Russian-made Sukhoi jet crossed two kilometers (1.2 miles) into Israeli airspace before a pair of Patriot missiles shot it down. IDF spokesperson Lieutenant-Colonel Jonathan Conricus confirmed that the plane was Syrian and that Israel communicated with Russia prior to the strike to ensure the jet was Syrian and not a Russian aircraft. "The only thing we know about the aircraft is that it crashed, most likely in the southern part of the Syrian Golan Heights," he added.



CALLER BOCKETS





Two mortar shells from Syria reportedly landed in the Sea of Galilee Wednesday in what the army said was spillover from the Syrian civil war.

The Sea of Galilee is more than 50 kilometers (30 miles) from the Syrian border, so the mortar shells would appear to have flown over the Golan Heights before landing. Hadashot TV news said they fell into the Sea of Galilee; the IDF said it was confirming exactly where the projectiles landed.

The rockets came from the southern part of the Syrian Golan Heights, where the regime of Bashar Assad has been completing its campaign against the last rebel villages remaining in the area. Incoming rocket sirens blared across the Israeli Golan Heights, sending residents of the area scrambling to bomb shelters.







An ancient boulder dislodged from the Western Wall on Sunday, crashing into the mixed-prayer plaza on Sunday afternoon, during Tisha B'Av. Nobody was injured; the 220 pound (100 kilo) stone's fall was caught on video.
