



- * A Palestinian was killed trying to stab a soldier at a West Bank this afternoon. No Israelis were injured. The incident, which took place at a bus stop between the Ariel settlement and the Barkan Industrial Park, is the third Palestinian terror attack in eight days.
- * Last week, two Israelis were killed when a Palestinian employee killed workers in that industrial park; two days later, two Israelis were wounded in a stabbing attack outside a northern West Bank army base.
- * Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison is strongly considering moving its embassy from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem.
- * A recent survey shows most Israelis want the government to continue its tough line against Iranian threats, *Israel Hayom* reported Wednesday. Over three-quarters (77%) of citizens surveyed agree that Israel must continue attacking Iranian targets in Syria.





Last night (Tuesday) at 3:40 AM, Gaza terrorists shot a rocket from Gaza that landed on a children's bedroom. They destroyed a whole house in the Israeli city of Beer Sheva. The children were saved thanks to the quick thinking of their mother who evacuated them just seconds before the rocket hit.

Russia and Iran have agreed on a mechanism to spare Iran the impact of what are intended by the US to be crippling sanctions on its oil industry from next month, an Israeli Foreign Ministry document reportedly warns. The Russian-Iranian deal was reportedly reached last month in Tehran, where Russian President Vladimir Putin, Iranian President Hassan Rouhani, and Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan held summit talks.

JERUSALEM (AP) – Israel's prime minister says he favors appointing an envoy to the Christian world, a sign of Israel's efforts to foster close ties with its Christian allies.

Benjamin Netanyahu spoke Sunday at a meeting in Jerusalem of visiting journalists from Christian media, where he was warmly received by reporters. He welcomed the idea suggested by one journalist to appoint such an emissary as "a great idea."

The summit reflects the strengthening ties between Israel and the evangelical Christian world. Israel has come to rely on widespread evangelical support in recent years, a move that has raised concerns among some Jews in Israel and abroad.

"A great alliance with the evangelicals is something we do not apologize for," Netanyahu said. "We have no better friends in the world."

"We have reached a red line. Israel needs to deal a heavy blow to Gaza and Hamas,"

Defense Minister Avigdor Lieberman said at the culmination of a security assessment near the Gaza border Tuesday.









Israel will not allow any more fuel into the Gaza Strip until violence against Israel from the Hamasrun enclave halts "entirely," Defense Minister Avigdor Liberman said Saturday.

"Until violence in the Gaza Strip stops entirely, including the launching of incendiary balloons and the burning of tires near Israeli communities, the supply of fuel and gas to the Gaza Strip will not be renewed," he said.

Israel on Friday halted the transfer of fuel to Gaza in response to heavy rioting and attacks at the border fence. Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh, whose terror group seeks to destroy Israel, vowed Saturday that mass rallies would continue until the "siege on Jerusalem, Al-Aqsa and all the lands of Palestine is lifted."





The Palestinian Authority and its allies long have insisted that the conflict in the Middle East boils down to a dispute over land.

If Israel would be willing to give up certain land and accept particular demands, peace could be achieved at last.

But a top adviser to Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas has made it clear that Islam and its objective to establish the rule of Shariah, not only in the region but over the entire world, is at the heart of the matter.

Mahmoud Al-Habbash, regarded at the PA's most important religious figure, said the conflict between Palestinians and Israelis is not a political conflict but a "battle" between Islam and "the culture of Satan."
