

Anti-Semitic incidents rose 57 percent in 2017 with 1,986 documented events, and many of these increases were seen in high schools and college campuses. There is Jew-hatred, Israel hatred, boycotts and bashing of Israel while the world ignores travesties of justice taking place throughout the world.

Trump at a campaign rally in Illinois: <u>"The scourge of anti-Semitism cannot be</u> ignored, cannot be tolerated and it cannot be allowed to continue... We must draw <u>a line in the sand and say very strongly, Never again!</u> [CSPAN]

"Over the centuries, Jews have been subjected to every kind of savage attack imaginable – from blood libels and massacres to pogroms and genocide – for <u>nothing more than the 'crime' of being Jewish</u>," Benjamin Netanyahu

Far-right candidate Jair Bolsonaro was elected president of Brazil. The victory is already fueling speculation that he will relocate <u>Brazil's embassy from Tel Aviv to</u> <u>Jerusalem</u>.







Last Shabbat - The deadliest anti-Semitic attack in the United States since 2014 – occurs at time when ADL has reported a historic increase in both anti-Semitic incidents and anti-Semitic online harassment."

Bowers, judging from his postings, was not a fan of Trump, "Trump is a globalist, not a nationalist. There is no #MAGA as long as there is a kike infestation."

Bowers, who is now hospitalized after being shot by the police, had shared on social media numerous antisemitic messages and said he wanted "all Jews to die." <u>Shortly before this roundup was published</u>, <u>officials announced the names of the 11 people</u> <u>killed. They ranged in age from 54-97.</u>









Ambassador Ron Dermer on MSNBC: "I saw what President Trump said yesterday at a rally in Illinois. <u>I'm not aware of a single non-Israeli</u> <u>leader that has made such a strong statement</u> in condemning anti-Semitism meaning he said to those who seek to destroy the Jewish people, we will destroy them. I have never heard a non-Israeli leader say that and we appreciated that... The difference in this president is that he has Jews in his family. So, I think there's no question in my mind that he wants to confront the anti-Semites."









Baroness Jenny Tonge, an independent peer in House of Lords, has suggested that the Israeli government bears some responsibility for Saturday's horrific terrorist attack on the Tree of Life Synagogue in Pittsburgh, which left 11 dead and six wounded.

Tonge responded to the attack on Facebook, writing: "Absolutely appalling and a criminal act, but does it ever occur to Bibi [Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu] and the present Israeli government that it's [sic] actions against Palestinians may be re-igniting antisemitism? I suppose someone will say that it is antisemitic to say so?"









This week's Torah portion dwelt with the Open Door policy of Abraham. Tragically, only on Shabbat does the Tree of Life have an open door policy

The name of the congregation in which the attack took place is *"The Tree of Life"*. But on this day it became identified with death.

What makes this all the more tragic is the event which was taking place at the time. The synagogue was in the midst of rejoicing with a family celebrating a *brit milah* and baby naming, affirming a child's identification with the Jewish people.

A celebration of life turned into a bloodbath. And we can only ask, will it never end?







An IDF airstrike killed three Palestinians doing something at the Israel-Gaza border fence. They were all teenagers, merely 13-14 years old. The IDF said the three were planting explosives, which the Palestinians denied. The Daily Telegraph's Raf Sanchez tweeted that the IDF doesn't have any video evidence that the kids were planting explosives, but added that the Palestinian explanations for why the kids were at the fence are inconsistent. In any event, Islamic Jihad vowed revenge.









Islamic Jihad terrorists fired some 40 rockets at Israel's citizens in the south, eliciting a sharp response from the IDF.

Israel's citizens in the south experienced a terrifying weekend as Gaza-based Palestinians terrorists fired dozens of rockets at civilian targets, repeatedly setting off Red Code alerts that sent them running for cover.

The Iron Dome defense system intercepted 13 rockets. All of the other rockets fell in open spaces or inside Gaza. None of the rockets caused injuries or damage.

The IDF stated that Palestinian Islamic Jihad was behind the attacks and carried them out with Iran's encouragement.







A new study on Palestinian textbooks found that the Palestinians still support terror and destroying Israel, and funnel misinformation to their children, which doesn't exactly surprise Israeli experts.

The four-year study by the Israel-based Meir Amit Intelligence and Terrorism Information Center found that after examining 364 Palestinian Authority schoolbooks for grades one through 12 from the years 2013 to 2018, children are still learning that a peaceful resolution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict is not an option.







Forty-three people were shot, including five who were shot fatally, over Halloween weekend in Mayor Rahm Emanuel's Chicago.

The Chicago Sun-Times reported that beginning with Friday, each day in the weekend became more violent. For example, "three wounded and one killed Friday night, 11 wounded and one killed on Saturday, and 25 shot – three fatally – on Sunday."

The five individuals killed were all were fatally shot while standing on a sidewalk, walking, or inside a vehicle.

Fox News reported that over 1,000 people were shot between Memorial Day and September 3, 2018, in Emanuel's Chicago.





The Palestinian Central Council (PCC), which met in Ramallah over two days, decided on Monday to end all commitments in the agreements the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO) has signed with Israel, to end security coordination and to revoke the Paris Economic Protocols which govern the economic cooperation with Israel.

Such moves mean the end of all peace protocols with Israel and the complete collapse of the Palestinian Authority (PA).

The PCC recommends eliminating all of the PLO and PA's commitments under their agreements with Israel, as well as suspending their recognition of the state of Israel until it recognizes the non-existent state of Palestine on the June 1967 borders with the eastern portion of Jerusalem as its capital.







Tehran strategic networks attacked, Hadashot TV says, hours after Israel revealed it tipped off Denmark about Iran murder plot, and days after Rouhani's phone was found bugged

I<u>ranian infrastructure and strategic networks have</u> <u>come under attack in the last few days by a computer</u> <u>virus similar to Stuxnet but "more violent, more</u> <u>advanced and more sophisticated," and Israeli officials</u> <u>are refusing to discuss what role, if any, they may have</u> <u>had in the operation, an Israeli TV report said</u> <u>Wednesday.</u>

The report came hours after Israel said its Mossad intelligence agency had thwarted an Iranian murder plot in Denmark, and two days after Iran acknowledged that President Hassan Rouhani's mobile phone had been bugged.
