






- This is an "limited" exclusive Tour led by Dan Stolebarger from HGE.



## US Put New Sanctions against Hezbollah

President Donald Trump signed legislation on Thursday that imposes new sanctions against Hezbollah, an Iranian backed terror group. "We will target, disrupt, and dismantle their operational and financing networks of which they had plenty," Trump said. Hezbollah was behind the bombing the Marine barracks in Beirut, Lebanon where 241 American service members were killed in 1983.

Israel's Minister of Education Naftali Bennett at the start of his party's Knesset faction meeting: "Thank you [Trump] for making the ayatollahs afraid again."










Shin Bet chief Nadav Argaman briefed the Knesset on Tuesday, painting a grim picture of the struggle to keep Israel secure.

"In the West Bank, the reality is very complex. We can discern a relative calm, but this quiet is deceptive," "Underneath the surface, the area is bubbling, and Hamas is trying with all its might to carry out attacks."

"In the past year, we have thwarted 480 attacks, including 219 Hamas squads and prevented 590 lone terrorists..

His briefing was made even more grim as he explained that Israeli security forces were still searching for the Palestinian terrorist that murdered Kim Yehezkel, and Ziv Hajbi, in the Barkan Industrial Park in Samaria last month







President Abdel Fattah el-Sissi has received Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas's approval for efforts to achieve an initial "period of calm" between Israel and Hamas in the Gaza Strip, the London-based Arabic paper Al-Hayat newspaper reported Thursday.

The first period of such a calm would last two to three weeks, followed by a longer six-month period.

The paper said Sissi told Abbas that after calm is achieved, Egypt will move forward on efforts to reach reconciliation between Hamas and the Palestinian Authority's Fatah movement and bring the two territories back under unified rule.





## Barkan Terrorist's Home To Be Partly Demolished

The IDF is now setting up to partially demolish the home of Barkan Industrial Zone terrorist, who murdered two Israelis. Kim Levengrond-Yehezkel, 28, from Rosh Ha'ayin, and Ziv Hajbi, a 35-year-old father of three from Rishon Letzion, were identified as the two victims.
