

Muslim groups apologize for video of children singing about decapitation"We are deeply saddened to have hurt our partners in the Jewish community and beyond," Philadelphia Muslim groups say, following backlash over video of children speaking in Arabic about beheading Jews and liberating Al-Aqsa Mosque.

A video uploaded to the group's Facebook page showed children dancing to a revolutionary anthem often used by Islamist groups, and two young girls reading from a prepared text. One said, "We will chop off their heads, and we will liberate ... Al-Aqsa Mosque."







Amid increasing tensions between the United States and Iran, U.S. President Donald Trump warned on Monday that Tehran will "suffer greatly" if "they do anything."

"We'll see what happens with Iran...If they do anything, they will suffer greatly," Trump told reporters in the Oval Office in response to reports that two oil tankers owned by Saudi Arabia and two others, one owned by the United Arab Emirates and another by Norway, were sabotaged, possibly by Tehran.

"It's going to be a bad problem for Iran if something happens. I can tell you that," said Trump. "They're not going to be happy. They're not going to be happy people."

The Pentagon has prepared a plan that envisions sending as many as 120,000 troops to the Middle East should Iran attack U.S. forces or accelerate work on nuclear weapons, the *New York Times* reports.

IRAN, IISA AND ISRAEI





Israel's Minister of Energy Yuval Steinitz said that Iran may attack Israel through its proxies, or even directly, in retaliation for the increased pressure brought on the Islamic Republic by the United States. Mr. Steinitz is a member of Israel's Security Cabinet.

Things are "heating up," Minister Steinitz said.

Most recently, the U.S. announced it was setting up Patriot missile batteries in the Mideast. Last week, the U.S. declared that its sending the USS Abraham Lincoln and a bomber squadron to the Mideast after it had received intelligence reports that Iran intended to attack U.S. forces in the region.

Tlaib told Yahoo News that the Holocaust gave her a "calming feeling" and "humbled" her because it reminded her that the suffering of the Palestinians had "provided" a safe haven to the Jews. Yet Tlaib remains defiant, knowing that trumpeting these patently false statements is a way to confer a modicum of legitimacy and shift the public discourse. In the face of widespread criticism, Tlaib declared: "All of you who are trying to silence me will fail miserably."

No, Rep. Tlaib. We will not remain silent. We will expose your words as gross distortions of history. We will hold Palestinians accountable when they are perpetrators of their own suffering – not the victims of it. And whether in the media, on Twitter, or the halls of Congress, we will call out anti-Semitism whenever we see it.








The Arabs mark Nakba Day on the date on which Israel declared its independence, a historic event they perceive as a "catastrophe." The terror groups have called on millions to arrive at the fence, and have threatened Israel that they will attack it with rockets if Israel harms the rioters.

The possibility of human losses is high, and therefore the prospects of an attack on Israel grow. The probability of another violent attack on Israel from the Gaza Strip is growing, as tensions in the Persian Gulf between the US and Iran mount and as the Eurovision song contest's finals near.

Two-thirds said religion played too large a role in the Middle East, while half said religious values were holding the region back." [Ozy]


