

BBC News bosses have been accused of "sanitizing" terror attacks after new editorial guidelines -- which go into effect later this month -- instruct reporters to stop using the word *terror* "unless quoting someone else." The Daily Mail quoted a senior news source saying, "It boils down to that phrase, 'One man's terrorist is another man's freedom fighter."

On Monday, Iranian Foreign Minister Mohammad Javad Zarif warned the U.S. that it "cannot expect to stay safe" after it "launched an economic war against Iran."

IAEA chief Yukiya Amano told reporters that Iran has accelerated its production of enriched uranium. But Amano said it is unclear when the Iranians may reach the limit set in the nuclear deal.

In an interview published by the New York Times on Saturday, Ambassador David Friedman said that some degree of annexation of the West Bank would be legitimate.

Senior Palestinian official Saeb Erekat has said any Israeli annexation policy would be tantamount to "US complicity with Israeli colonial plans."On Monday, the Washington Post published leaked remarks made by US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo, who told US Jewish leaders in a closed-door conversation that the plan might not "gain traction." When asked about Pompeo's skepticism, Trump told reporters outside the White House: "He may be right."





Hamas leader thanks Iran for providing missiles that can hit Tel Aviv

In a May 30, 2019 speech that aired on Al-Aqsa TV, Hamas leader Yahya Sinwar said that the Grad and Fajr missiles that were launched at Israeli cities had been provided by Iran or developed locally with the financial and technical support of Iran








A former deputy head of the UN's atomic watchdog said Wednesday that Iran is capable of producing a nuclear bomb in six to eight months. In an interview with Israel's Army Radio, Olli Heinonen said that Israel and the Gulf states "have a reason to worry."

Heinonen said that despite assertions to the contrary by the current leadership of the UN's International Atomic Energy Agency, which he left in 2010, Tehran has not been adhering to the 2015 nuclear deal. "Iran is actually weaponizing uranium enrichment without making a weapon," he claimed. He said that according to his personal, "perhaps back-of-the-envelope" calculation, Iran could produce a nuclear weapons in six to eight months, "if they put in their maximum effort."





"So Iran is a place that was extremely hostile when I first came into office," Trump told British television station ITV.

"They were a terrorist nation No. 1 in the world at that time and probably maybe are today."

When asked if he thought he would need to take military action, he said: "There's always a chance. Do I want to? No. I'd rather not. But there's always a chance."

When asked if he was prepared to talk to Rouhani: Trump replied, "Yeah of course. I would much rather talk."



MAD THE CHANGED?







Israel faces no major security threat from Hamas at this time, IDF Intelligence Directorate Chief Maj. Gen. Tamir Heyman said on Wednesday at the Israel Defense and Homeland Expo in Tel Aviv.,,"Hamas is extremely deterred from war and is willing to stay on some kind of track of a [cease-fire] arrangement," Heyman told his audience. "They very much do not desire war."

The "wild card" in Gaza, he said, is the rival Palestinian Islamic Jihad (PIJ). The much smaller terrorist group "has higher explosive potential," he said. It is "a highly unstable force that fundamentally still views itself as a resistance group that must act aggressively." The PIJ, which is a full Iranian proxy, may thus try to drag Hamas into a war it doesn't want. This is not a secret that Israeli Intelligence had to ferret out, however, as the PIJ leader publicly threatened war for this summer right after May's unofficial cease-fire agreement was reached.

After a two-year hiatus, the project, up and running again since Sunday, is now housed in a previously abandoned tree-filled grove in east Jerusalem, located at the nexus of the Mount of Olives and Hebrew University's Mount Scopus campus. As in the previous nearby location, paying volunteers sort through a jumble of debris and earth that was illegally excavated by Muslim authorities from the Temple Mount, a site holy to all three monotheistic religions. This army of thousands of tourists and native Israelis have found priceless treasures, including 5,000 coins, inscriptions, mountains of pottery, Egyptian-era cultic items, jewelry, remnants of warfare, and a plethora of fauna remains: bone tools, the charred bone remains of Temple Mount sacrifices, and even pig bones from Roman pagan and Christian periods.







Intelligence on Iranian threats in the first days of May was "compelling" and that the threats were "advanced, imminent and very specific."

The pattern of intelligence on Iranian preparations for potential attacks emerged as the Trump administration took a pair of highly public actions meant to penalize Iran. The first was the State Department's designation of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps as a terrorist organization. The second, perhaps more consequential, move was an April 22 announcement that waivers for American sanctions on buyers of Iranian oil would not be renewed when they expired May 2, meaning Iran lost vital oil export revenues.


Gen. Joseph Dunford, chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, said last week looked like a pattern of Iranian plotting against the U.S. and other targets in the region. Dunford said that on May 3, the U.S. sent a message to Iranian officials "just to make it clear they understood that we would hold them accountable should something place in the region."





ULTIMATE DEAL WATCH — On Tuesday, White House officials confirmed that Egypt, Jordan and Morocco have accepted an invitation to attend the 'economic workshop' in Bahrain later this month. In a statement quoted in the Jordanian media, King Abdullah II said that "Jordan has to attend international summits that deal with the Palestinian issue" to avoid "being left out."

Palestinian Authority spokesman Ibrahim Melhim said the PA "deeply regrets the declaration of Cairo and Amman about its participating in the workshop and call on them and all brotherly and friendly countries to withdraw from participating in the workshop."



Rabbi Kaduri Predicted 40 Years Ago That Current Election Difficulties Presage Messiah.

The 'Iron Dome' for mosquitoes – by Yisrael Wolman: "Israeli technology start-up Bzigo has developed a machine that scans a room for mosquitoes and once it detects that it has landed, the device points a laser beam at it, while sending a message to a phone app, allowing the recipient to easily locate the pest and kill it. The device was developed over three years and looks like a box the size of a compact smartphone that can be connected to the wall or stand-alone on a flat surface. Although the current model only helps locate the mosquito, according to Bzigo CEO Nadav Benedek, they are working a future model that will be able to eliminate the mosquito on its own."
