

- * Lieberman has insisted on passing a new law mandating that young ultra-Orthodox men be drafted into the military, like most other Jewish males. Netanyahu's ultra-Orthodox allies demand that the draft exemptions remain in place.

- * At least 11 fires were sparked Wednesday in southern Israel by balloon-borne incendiary devices sent over the security fence from the southern Gaza Strip.








In a brief speech to the press on Monday at the Knesset, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu warned against "unnecessary elections" and called for all parties to act responsibly. To bolster his argument, he noted that President Donald Trump himself had expressed his hopes that a coalition would be formed.

A strong U.S.-Israel relationship carries weight with the Israeli public and Netanyahu is hoping, also with Avigdor Liberman, the main holdout to forming a government. According to *Maariv*, Netanyahu wants members of the Trump administration to step in and pressure Liberman to join the coalition.







ULTIMATE DEAL WATCH – Russia criticized the upcoming Bahrain summit as an attempt at "imposing an alternative vision" for the Israeli-Palestinian peace process. "The persistent desire by the U.S. to replace a comprehensive political solution with some economic 'bonuses' for the Palestinians is of deep concern." "At this difficult stage, collective efforts to launch Israeli-Palestinian negotiations are needed, rather than unilateral 'deals' of opportunistic nature."

Russia and China, along with the Palestinian Authority (PA), have declared that they will not participate in the U.S. peace plan workshops scheduled for June 25 and 26 in Bahrain.

IAESTRIKES SYRA





The Israel Defense Forces has confirmed that it launched a strike against a Syrian anti-aircraft battery on Monday night, after the battery fired on an Israeli fighter jet flying a routine mission over northern Israel.

"The IDF views with gravity any threat against its planes and takes active measures to defend them," the IDF said in a statement. According to the IDF the Syrian anti-aircraft missile, which was launched Monday and landed in Syrian territory, originated in Quneitra on the edge of the Golan Heights.

The Israeli strike on the launcher is reported to have killed a Syrian officer and a soldier, as well as damaging a military vehicle. No Israeli casualties or damage were reported.





In UAE, Bolton accuses Iran of seeking nuclear weapons

Iran has set a July 7 deadline for Europe to offer better terms to the unraveling nuclear deal, otherwise, it will resume enrichment closer to weapons level. Bolton declined to say what the U.S. would do in response to that.

"There's no reason for them to do [higher enrichment] unless it is to reduce the breakout time to nuclear weapons," Bolton said.














Sappers working to disable landmines in the Land of the Monasteries found out last week, as the Israel Defense Force's Combat Engineering Unit detonated the largest minefield at the site to date in the seven heavily-mined church compounds on the Israeli-Jordanian border. (900 landmines at once). Sappers detonated a line of anti-tank mines with a single explosion that sent dust dozens of meters into the air. There are approximately 6,500 landmines in the Land of the Monasteries, and this 900-mine explosion was the biggest single detonation since de-mining work began at the site over a year ago. Christians believe that Qasr al-Yahud, located about 10 kilometers (six miles) east of Jericho, is the spot on the Jordan River where Jesus was baptized. For decades, the bullet-pocked church buildings stood shuttered, yellow signs flapping in the wind warning of landmines.



The three churches in charge of Jerusalem's holiest Christian site say they have reached an agreement to begin a multi-million dollar renovation of the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.

Leaders of the Greek Orthodox, Catholic and Armenian churches issued a statement Monday announcing the project to restore the foundations and flooring of the church, where many Christians believe Jesus was crucified, entombed and resurrected.

The Church of the Holy Sepulcher is shared by multiple Christian sects under a status quo management agreement. Even perceived alterations to the status quo have resulted in arguments or violence.
