

Iran has exceeded a key limitation on how much nuclear fuel it can possess under the 2015 international pact curbing its nuclear program, effectively declaring that it would no longer respect an agreement that President Trump abandoned more than a year ago, state media reported on Monday.

It's unclear whether the Bahrain conference will ultimately lead to a successful outcome but has it helped further another US goal: bringing together its Israeli and Gulf Arab allies in what could be a strategic realignment in the Middle East?

In recent years the Mossad has been making an effort to locate the grave of the Israeli intelligence operative Eli Cohen, "our man in Damascus", who was executed in Syria in 1965, and to bring his remains home for burial in Israel.

Israel's first Straight Pride March branded the 'Family March' kicked off in the Neve Shaanan neighborhood of Haifa without a hitch. The march's goal is to "stress the importance of the traditional family in light of an active anti-family agenda from the LGBT lobby" one of the organizers told Breaking Israel News.



At an international conference Tuesday, Foreign Minister Yisrael Katz said Israel is building up its military in preparation for a possible war in the region due to the rising tension between the United States and Iran.

"It should be taken into account that mistaken calculations by the [Iranian] regime ... are liable to bring about a shift from the 'gray zone' to the 'red zone' - that is, a military conflagration," he said at the IDC Herzliya Conference.

"We must be prepared for this, and thus the State of Israel continues to devote itself to building up its military might for the event that it will have to respond to escalation scenarios," he added.





Its back against the wall, Iran has yet to bat an eye

Iran's announcement that it was intentionally violating the 2015 nuclear deal has made it clear that in many ways, we are seeing a return to the overt and covert race that was waged between Jerusalem and Tehran earlier this decade

On Monday, another member of Tehran's parliament warned the country would destroy Israel in 30 minutes if Iran were to come under US attack. While this is absolute rubbish in practical terms, it is a testament to the combative spirit prevalent in Tehran, which has also found expression in the recent statements made by Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah...







Iran's president warned Europe Wednesday that his country would "take the next step" in increasing its uranium enrichment this coming Sunday, and enrich to "any amount that we want." If signatories of the nuclear accord do not fulfill their commitments, Rouhani said, levels of enrichment will go beyond the 3.67 percent limit agreed under the deal.

"In any amount that we want, any amount that is required, we will take over 3.67," he said. "Our advice to Europe and the United States is to go back to logic and to the negotiating table," Rouhani added.

To reach weapons-grade levels, uranium must be enriched to over 90%. But due to the nature of the enrichment process, once Iran reaches 20% purity it is a relatively short jump to reach the 90% enrichment needed for fissile material used in nuclear bombs.





The United States has deployed F-22 Raptor stealth fighter jets to Qatar for the first time, according to the US Air Forces Central Military Command on Friday.

The deployment, to the Al Udeid Air Base, a forward headquarters of U.S. Central Command and headquarters of U.S. Air Forces Central Command, is intended to "defend American forces and interests," said officials in a statement. It was not stated how many of the jets were deployed.

The move augments the recent U.S. military build-up in the Middle East amid tensions with Iran. Several nuclear-capable bombers were deployed to the Gulf in May together with a U.S. carrier strike group after the U.S. Defense Department warned of a possible Iranian attack against American forces in the region.








At least 16 people were killed in a series of strikes on military targets in Damascus and Homs overnight Sunday, Arab media outlets reported Monday morning. The strikes were attributed to Israel, but the IDF declined to comment.

Reports said that the strikes included about 10 separate sorties that targeted military infrastructure belonging to Hezbollah, the Iranian Revolutionary Guard Corps, and Iranian-backed Shiite militias.

So let's start saying the truth out loud. Because to be honest, everyone knows it.






Fatah Deputy Chairman Mahmoud Al-Aloul:

Plan to pump desalinated water to Sea of Galilee may open diplomatic floodgates

Technology has doubled the amount of water available to Israelis, and a new NIS 1 billion plan to bring treated water to the northern freshwater lake will increase it even further

The project, which is expected to be completed in about four to five years, will mark the first time in the world that a shrinking body of natural water is supplemented with desalinated water. If successful, the plan could have far-ranging consequences for other countries dealing with water scarcity, providing a new model for banking excess water for periods of severe drought.





On Sunday, the City of David hosted the event opening the Pilgrim's Road, the stairway archaeologists believe was the main thoroughfare for pilgrims ascending to the Temple Mount. Originally constructed to ascend from the Shiloah Pool to the Temple, the stairway was hidden, buried under a potato field. "The discovery of the Pilgrimage Road was an unprecedented scientific feat of biblical proportions," he wrote. "Unlike most archaeological digs which begin from the ground down, this excavation was done subterraneously, beneath the hustle and bustle of modern Jerusalem," he wrote. "Dozens of fiber optic cable cameras were used to decipher where to excavate, while maps and diagrams made by archaeologists over the last century and a half paved the way forward," Spielman added.
