# NEWS BITES

Bomb dropping drones: New threat emerges from Gaza.

Liberman says a messianic-religious extremist government will emerge after the elections unless a large voter turnout in places like Tel Aviv can stop it.

Bibi (who is behind in the polls) promises to apply Israeli sovereignty to West Bank settlements, starting with the Jordan Valley, if re-elected.

Trump fires foreign policy hawk Bolton, citing strong disagreements. Officials and a source close to Trump said the US president had grown weary of Bolton's hawkish tendencies and bureaucratic battles. As national security adviser, Bolton argued against Trump's suggestions of a possible meeting with the Iranian leadership and pressed the president not to let up pressure on North Korea.





# BREAKING NEWS



*Netanyahu said war against Hamas in Gaza appeared to be inevitable. By World Israel News Staff*

"There will be no choice but to enter a campaign, to war against Gaza," Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said in an interview with Israel's Kan public radio on Thursday.



"Israeli citizens know perfectly well that I act responsibly and with discretion. I'll will open the campaign at the most appropriate moment, I will determine it," the prime minister said.

Netanyahu said, referring to his detractors, "Stop engaging in harsh criticism... I'm not going to act according to your tweets and your needling."



"When you are in charge you have to decide how you're going to conduct the war... I won't start it a second before conditions are optimal. I won't go one minute before we're prepared. And I won't start it in one minute. We're preparing for a different kind of war, and this is my responsibility," Netanyahu said.





# TRUMP PLAN LEAKED



The report notes that Liberman revealed the details shortly before resigning from his post. Liberman denies the report. According to the PA officials with whom Liberman reportedly met, revealed that the plan includes the establishment of a full Palestinian state in Gaza.

Liberman also reportedly told them that the deal would give them control over Area A as well as smaller sections of B and even Area C. The accord does not involve the evacuation of any Jewish presence in Judea and Samaria. The report also states that the deal will ensure that Israel maintains full authority over all border crossings.

The deal also ensures Israeli control over most of Jerusalem and that the IDF maintains its presence in the Jordan Valley.





# US - ISRAEL THREAT



US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo warned Lebanon on Wednesday, Sept. 4, that Israel is aware of a second, bigger Iranian-Hizballah missile factory and that they are preparing to bomb it reports Debka. Pompeo noted that Israel intelligence is well aware that Iran and Hizballah were constructing another, more significant factory in Lebanon, to help upgrade their missile project. They were hoping to utilize the Nebi Shait plant as a red herring for Jerusalem.





# IRANIAN MISSILES



An Iran-backed militia in Syria fired several rockets toward northern Israel in the predawn hours of Monday morning, but they fell short of the border, the army said.

According to the IDF, the attack was carried out by operatives of a Shiite militia operating under the command of Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps' Quds Force. The IDF said the rockets were fired from the suburbs outside Damascus.

The alleged attack came amid reports of a series of airstrikes against a pro-Iranian militia in eastern Syria, which killed 18 fighters, according to a Britain-based war monitor.

In a statement, the IDF said it "holds the Syrian regime responsible for every action that takes place in Syria."





# DRONE THREATS



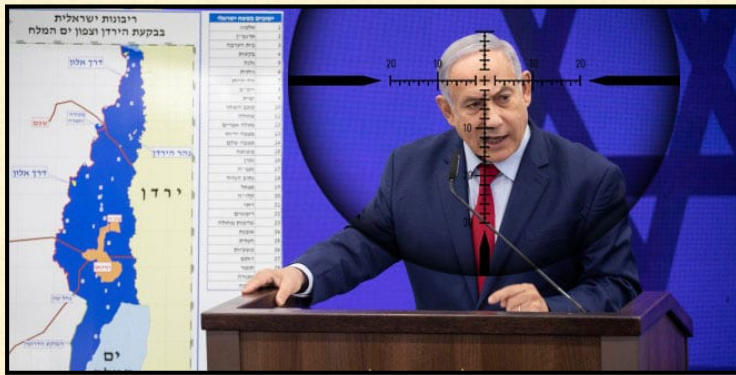
The current hostilities in Gaza are on a low flame but could easily spiral out of control. Both Israel and Hamas want calm, certainly before the election in Israel. But Palestinian Islamic Jihad, at the behest of its Iranian master, is now weaponizing tiny drones to destabilize the situation. Does the IDF have an answer?

The drone attack on Saturday was the second of its type attempted by PIJ. In the first, the organization tried dropping a mortar shell on a tank. On Saturday, the group seemingly used a small explosive device or improvised grenade.





# ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT



Almost immediately following Netanyahu's press conference where he laid out his plan to assert Israeli sovereignty over the Jordan Valley, Hamas launched a rocket into Ashdod, where Netanyahu was speaking on Tuesday.

As soon as the rocket was launched at Ashdod, Netanyahu was briefly whisked off of the stage only to return once the red alert siren ended shortly after 9:00 pm. The IDF reported that two rockets were fired at Israel which forced the red alert siren to go off in Israel's southern Gaza Belt communities. Both rockets were intercepted by the iron dome missile defense system.





# ARCHEOLOGICAL FIND



A 2,600-year-old bulla, or seal, bearing the Hebrew words "Adenyahu Asher Al Habayit" which translate to "Adenyahu by Appointment of the House" was uncovered three weeks ago. Adenyahu was a son of King David. It was found by a volunteer sifting through dirt excavated from 2013 under Robinson's Arch near the Western Wall. The biblical title 'Asher Al Habayit' was the highest ranking ministerial position beneath the king during reigns of the kings of Judea and Israel. It is undoubtedly of great significance," Israeli archaeologist Eli Shukron of the Israel Antiquities Authority said.
