The PA will no longer recognize distinctions in West Bank Areas A, B, and C and now regards it all as under Palestinian sovereignty. Ramallah has already begun issuing building permits in areas where Israel has administrative and security control.

After Firing the First Shot, Lebanon Begs U.S, France to Save Them From Israel

Iran is refusing to cooperate with a UN probe of a Tehran warehouse believed to be holding nuclear equipment and radioactive material. The site was first disclosed by Israel following the Mossad's 2018 theft of a trove of Iranian nuclear documents.

Iran on Wednesday said it would take another step away from a 2015 nuclear deal by starting to develop centrifuges to speed up its uranium enrichment but it also gave European powers two more months to try to save the multilateral pact.

The Trump administration may allow U.S. citizens born in Jerusalem to list "Jerusalem, Israel" on their passports, JNS reports.



IDF CHIEF TO UNIFIL



IDF chief to UNIFIL: Stop Hezbollah's missile program, or we will!

IDF chief Aviv Kohavi on Sunday called on United Nations peacekeepers and the Lebanese government to take action against the Hezbollah terror group's precision missile project, indicating that Israel would be forced to act if they didn't.



Meeting head of UN peacekeeping force, Kohavi says Israel will not tolerate terror group's attacks on its soldiers and civilians, nor let it build precision missiles.



HEZBOLLAH PRANKED



After Hezbollah fired Kornet anti-tank missiles toward Moshav Avivim in Israel's north, the terror group celebrated its great victory, sending an "urgent message" reporting that an IDF vehicle "was struck by a Kornet missile and all the vehicle's passengers were killed or wounded." Not only that, it reported that a senior IDF officer was among the dead.

According to the Ynet news site, Lebanese media quickly disseminated Hezbollah's news and Lebanon's Prime Minister Saad Hariri immediately reached out to Secretary of State Mike Pompeo to update him on the seriousness of the situation. Two hours later, the truth came out when Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu took to Israeli television, saying "We have no casualties - not even a scratch."



IAF CALLED BACK



One day after Hezbollah fired anti-tank missiles at Israeli positions near the Lebanese border, the Israeli military revealed that it was ready to deliver a decisive blow to the terror group's missile program, according to report by a Channel 12 News.

The IDF sources that relayed the information to Channel 12 claimed that IAF fighter jets had taken flight on Sunday to initiate the counter-strike, but were sent back to Israeli territory when Hezbollah's attack on Israel failed to cause any casualties.

According to Israeli officials, the terror group's inability to inflict damage on Israeli positions "saved" Hezbollah chief Hassan Nasrallah from Israel "crushing Hezbollah's rocket project." According to the quoted officials, the Israeli jets were armed and ready to strike Hezbollah facilities in Lebanon.

AYELET SHAKED



Israel must undertake a large-scale military operation in the Gaza Strip, Yamina Party leader Ayelet Shaked said on Monday.

Speaking at an election event in Beit Shemesh, the former justice minister told the audience that Israel should not be tolerating the missiles and incendiary kites and balloons being launched from Gaza, or the violent weekly demonstrations along the Gaza border.

"We must choose the time that is best for us, evacuate the Israeli citizens who live in towns along the Gaza [border] to give us maximum flexibility, and we must uproot the terror from within Gaza," said Shaked.



RIBI VISITS HEBRON



The Palestinian Authority continues to incite violence. Following yesterday's visit by Israeli leaders to Hebron, the PA is now saying that Israel Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's presence there was an act of "obvious war" and that he "defiled" the city: "The [PA] Ministry of Religious Affairs emphasized that [Israeli] occupation Prime Minister [Benjamin Netanyahu]'s defilement of Hebron and the Ibrahimi Mosque (i.e., Cave of the Patriarchs) is nothing but obvious war, in which he has declared his blatant hatred towards the Palestinian presence in Hebron and the Ibrahimi Mosque, which is a purely Islamic mosque."



IRANIAN BASE IN SYRIA



Iran is building a new military base in Syria that will host thousands of troops, Fox News reported on Tuesday citing Western intelligence sources.

According to the report, the "Imam Ali" base is being completed by the Islamic Revolutionary Guards' Quds force under orders from the top command. Fox said the report was verified by Israeli satellite imaging firm ImageSat International, whose analysts said that images confirm precision-guided missiles could be housed at five newly constructed buildings within the compound. ISI said construction of the base could be completed within months.

There is an American army position less than 200 miles from the new Iranian compound.
