Israeli Defense Minister Naftali Bennett approved the development of a new Jewish neighborhood in Hebron.

Netanyahu wants to stay in office only to annex Jordan Valley, Likud claims

Latest offer from PM's party would see him leave post to Gantz within six months; minister says it aims to take advantage of 'rare opportunity' of tacit US backing for annexation

During a press conference on Sunday, Netanyahu said that the two discussed "the historic opportunity we have in the coming months, including recognizing the Jordan Valley as the eastern border of Israel," reported the Israeli broadcaster Kan.

The two also talked about a security pact between the United States and Israel, reported The Jerusalem Post.

Netanyahu said such developments "we could only dream about, but which now we have the opportunity to implement."

OBDAN BEDARES







The Jordanian Army conducted a series of military maneuvers this week simulating an attempted invasion of the kingdom, but which also appeared to be a message to Israel.

The Jordanian media reported that the maneuvers involved large numbers of ground and air vehicles, and were aimed at "destroying the vanguard of the enemy and the bridges that can be used as crossing points" into Jordanian territory.

While the official Jordanian reports did not explicitly mention Israel, the reference to the Battle of Karameh and that fact that the drill focused on an invasion via bridges—that is, bridges over the Jordan River that forms the border between the two countries—strongly implies a connection.



ANNEXATION WATCH





Israeli military officials have warned Netanyahu that annexing the Jordan Valley could imperil Israel's 25-year-old peace treaty with Jordan, Israeli Channel 12 reported. In a meeting with Likud members on Tuesday, Netanyahu said he wants to seize the opportunity to gain U.S. support for annexation before the 2020 U.S. election campaign kicks into high gear.

BANIAN MASSILES





Iran has been secretly hiding short-range ballistic missiles in Iraq capable of hitting Israeli, American and Saudi targets. US defense and intelligence officials told the New York Times that American deterrence failed as Iran capitalized on Iraq's unrest.

Meanwhile, Arab media reports picked up in Israel reported large explosions at an Iranian base on the Syria-Iraq border. The strategic border crossing town of Abu Kamal has been the target of a number of strikes attributed to Israel this year. Israeli officials declined to comment.







An a surprising break from previous years, 13 countries voted to oppose an annual resolution buoying a pro-Palestinian UN agency traditionally critical of Israel.

The resolution, which includes a call to halt Israeli settlements being constructed in the West Bank, still passed with a large majority voting in favor of continuing to support the Palestinian cause and finding a "Peaceful Settlement of the Question of Palestine", as the resolution is titled.

However, for the very first time, Germany, the Czech Republic, Austria, Bulgaria, Denmark, Estonia, Greece, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Romania, Slovakia, Brazil, and Colombia voted against the resolution regarding the Division of Palestinian Rights at the UN Secretariat.






Abbas's Wife had Surgery in Israel

Doctors in Israel performed leg surgery on Amina Abbas, the wife of Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas, at a private clinic near Tel Aviv. Earlier this month Israel allowed the mother-in-law of Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh into the country for a cancer treatment at a Jerusalem hospital.

A recent survey of students at the University of California Berkeley revealed many students who claimed to advocate for the Palestinian cause actually have little knowledge about the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.

Ron E. Hassner, the Helen Diller Family Chair in Israel Studies at UC Berkeley recently surveyed 230 students at the University of California Berkeley. Despite most students purporting to care "deeply" about the Israeli occupation of Palestinian territories, "75% of those students cannot locate those territories on a map and 84% cannot name the decade (let alone the year) in which that occupation began," Hassner wrote in an essay detailing the results of the survey.



Pro-Palestinian Rally in New York City Promises Violent Riots on Every College Campus


At a rally in Times Square, BDS activists called to perpetrate an intifada, usually used to describe violence and terrorism, on all the college campuses in America in what is becoming a common rally cry for the movement.

JTA – Christmas ornaments and bottle openers featuring the site of the former Auschwitz Nazi death camp that were for sale on Amazon were removed from the site Sunday.

The products were taken off the website hours after the Auschwitz Memorial and Museum on Sunday morning in Europe asked the site to remove the items.

The museum called Amazon out in a tweet earlier, saying, "Selling 'Christmas ornaments' with images of Auschwitz does not seem appropriate. Auschwitz on a bottle opener is rather disturbing and disrespectful. We ask @amazon to remove the items of those suppliers."
