
A 5.1 magnitude earthquake hit at 5 AM local time on Friday less than 30 miles from the 1,000-megawatt Bushehr nuclear power plant, Iran's only operating nuclear power plant located on the southwest Gulf coast.

Days of torrential rainfall this week have brought the water level in the Sea of Galilee, Israel's major freshwater lake, up by some 20 centimeters (7.9 inches), local authorities reported Saturday.

USEMBASSY ATTACKED





Twice in a span of 40 years, the Islamic Republic of Iran has managed to humiliate the world's preeminent superpower by striking at one of its main symbols, and in the same exact way. In many ways, Tuesday's humiliation was even more stinging. The "Green Zone" in Baghdad, which houses the US embassy along with other embassies and government buildings, is a fortified area, perhaps one of the most guarded compounds on the planet, surrounded by outer and inner security rings of Iraqi soldiers and security personnel. Dozens of roadblocks and checkpoints are positioned on the roads leading to the Green Zone.

In hindsight, it appears the compound's guards stood idly by, didn't try preventing the thousands of protesters from entering through the main gate and allowed them to advance unimpeded toward the US Embassy, which cost hundreds of millions of dollars to build.

Iraqi Shiite militia supporters broke into the US Embassy compound in Baghdad on Tuesday after smashing a main door and setting fire to a reception area, prompting tear gas and sounds of gunfire.

An Associated Press reporter at the scene saw flames rising from inside the compound and at least three US soldiers on the roof of the main building. There was a fire at the reception area near the parking lot of the compound but it was unclear what had caused it. A man on a loudspeaker urged the mob not to enter the compound, saying: "The message was delivered."

The embassy attack followed deadly US airstrikes on Sunday that killed 25 fighters of the Iran-backed militia in Iraq, the Kataeb Hezbollah. The US military said it was in retaliation for last week's killing of an American contractor in a rocket attack on an Iraqi military base that it had blamed on the militia.

HAD FARHAN AL-AMIR





The Washington Post reported on Tuesday that one of the leaders of the riots that threatened the embassy in Baghdad was Hadi al-Amiri, head of the Badr Organization, one of the largest pro-Iran militias in Iraq.

Hadi Farhan al-Amiri, the Iraqi Minister of Transportation at the time, was a guest of former President Barack Obama at the White House in 2011.




Red lines: Seth Frantzman writes in The Daily Beast that – despite the close alliance between Israel and the U.S. on the Iranian threat – the two countries have very different red lines. "For Israel, the red line has been Iran's effort to transfer precision guided munitions through Iraq and Syria to Hezbollah in Lebanon, and its increasing role in Syria close to Israel's borders," he noted. "For the Trump administration, the red line has become further Iranian proxy attacks on U.S. forces in Iraq or Syria.



PPE-EWBTWE STRUKE







Defense Sec Mark Esper told reporters "The game has changed, and we're prepared to do what is necessary to defend our personnel and our interests and our partners in the region."

The Pentegon's decision to leave wiggle room for preemptive strikes comes after the US launched precision guided bombs against five targets housing Khataib Hezbollah on Dec. 31, prompting the embassy breach.



ANTI-SEMITISM ON THE BISE





You can't ignore a spike in antisemitic attacks in the New York area. A man armed with a machete injured five people at a Chanuka celebration in the New York area on Saturday night. On Friday morning, a man walked into Chabad's world headquarters in Brooklyn and chillingly threatened to shoot it up. See local coverage for details on the other attacks. To the outrage of the Jewish community, one suspect was released without bail thanks to loopholes in bail reform laws.

Some 135 Palestinian non-governmental organizations rejected financial assistance from the European Union over a refusal to renounce ties to terrorism.

As 2019 ended, the Palestinian Authority emphasized that it views the entire State of Israel as "Palestine" and rewards anyone who reinforces this message. Accordingly the PA Ministry of Education awarded first prize in an art competition to a student who in her painting included the PA map of "Palestine," which presents all of Israel as part of "Palestine" together with the PA areas and the Gaza Strip.







Netanyahu pointed out that in 2017 the US administration had recognized Jerusalem as the capital of Israel and in 2018 had relocated the US Embassy in Israel to the city, not to mention leaving the 2015 Iran deal – "and this year, we annexed the Golan Heights and [the US] stated that settlements are legal," he said.

"Our rivals would not have achieved that - not only because they aren't capable of it, but because that is not their path. In the next few years, we will decide on our borders. We will get the Americans to recognize the application of Israeli sovereignty to the Jordan Valley, and all the settlements in Judea and Samaria, and we will make peace deals with Arab states,"

Netanyahu declared.

JESUS-1ST SHAHD
