




The image shows that Fatah intends for "Palestine" to include all of Israel, and the accompanying text stresses this further. A man with a *keffiyeh* is lying on the PA map of "Palestine" that presents all of Israel as "Palestine" together with the PA areas. The man is covering the entire map with his body from the Jordan River to the Med - which rejects the existence of Israel in any borders. One of the man's legs is crossed over the other, showing the sole of his sandal on which is written: "The deal of the century" - referring to **US President Donald Trump's** Middle East peace plan. In Arab culture showing someone the sole of your shoe is considered an insult and scorn.










Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's meeting on Monday in Uganda to discuss normalizing Israeli-Sudanese diplomatic ties with Gen. Abdel-Fattah Burhan, the head of Sudan's transitional government, sparked a wave of critical reactions from Palestinians.

"This meeting is a stab in the back of the Palestinian people and a blatant departure from the Arab Peace Initiative at a time when the administration of [US] President Donald Trump and Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu are trying to liquidate the Palestinian cause," said Saeb Erekat, secretary-general of the Palestine Liberation Organization and chief PA negotiator, in a statement carried on official news agency WAFA.









Abbas 'won't be in office for much longer,' Palestinian officials say

The Palestinian leader has deliberately refrained from naming a successor and concerns are growing that chaos will follow his departure from office. Israeli defense officials believe Palestinian intelligence chief Maj. Gen. Majid Faraj will most likely succeed Abbas.





Palestinians in Gaza are now threatening to send balloons carrying tear gas grenades. On Monday alone, sappers defused at least nine balloons suspected of carrying bombs and incendiary devices.

Haaretz reports that Israeli officials believe the rising number of balloon attacks is a Hamas effort to embarrass Netanyahu ahead of Israel's March 2 elections.







Do three terror attacks in 12 hours suggest a new wave of Palestinian violence is on the way? This morning, an Arab Israeli armed with a pistol shot a police officer on the Temple Mount. Last night, 12 soldiers were injured in a Jerusalem car-ramming attack. And shortly before this email went out, reports broke of a shooting near the West Bank settlement of Dolev, lightly injuring an Israeli soldier. Not coincidentally, an animated video glorifying Palestinian terror attacks was posted to TikTok. On the Gaza side of the equation, IDF air strikes hit terror targets after Palestinians continued launching mortars and balloons carrying explosives.

In recent days, Palestinian leaders have threatened violence in opposition to the US peace plan launched last week.






Palestinian terrorists committed 2 shooting attacks and 1 car ramming attack in the last 24 hours, just 3 days after the former head of Palestinian Authority security services, Tawfiq Tirawi, called on the security services not to "pursue any fighter." In other words, Tirawi called for the Palestinian police not to notify Israel about terrorists or terrorist acts that they are about to commit.



'Accept Trump's Plan, or You'll Regret It Later!' Saudi Journalist Warns Palestinians ... A Saudi Foreign Ministry reaction to the plan's release stated, inter alia, that "the Kingdom appreciates the efforts made by President Trump's administration to develop a comprehensive Palestinian-Israeli peace plan, and it encourages the start of direct peace negotiations between the sides under U.S. sponsorship, in which any dispute regarding details of the plan will be settled. This is in order to advance the peace process and arrive at an agreement that will actualize the brother Palestinian people's legitimate rights."







Defense Minister Naftali Bennett held a working meeting with his U.S. counterpart in Washington on Wednesday.

According to Ynet, Bennett and U.S. Secretary of Defense Mark Esper "discussed at length the regional threats, most notably Iran's aggression, Sources close to Bennett have said that the defense minister is looking to acquire advanced weaponry to assist Israel in removing Iranian forces in Syria, reports *Arutz Sheva*.

Israel considers Iranian entrenchment along its border in Syria an unacceptable threat and has allegedly carried out hundreds of airstrikes to slow Iran's buildup in the region and its supply of weapons to Hezbollah in Lebanon.







"Mr Graham's rhetoric is repeatedly and unnecessarily inflammatory and in my opinion represents a risk to the social cohesion of our city."
