- * Israel set for nationwide lockdown from Tuesday afternoon to early Friday
- * If Israel finds a vaccine for coronavirus, boycotters can still take it, Omar Barghouti, a figurehead of the anti-Israel Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) movement says.
- Minister Gordon Brown who called on world leaders to form a "temporary" global government in response to the coronavirus pandemic. This week it was the United Nations Secretary-General asking nations to contribute at least ten percent of their annual income, essentially a global tax







ISPACIE HEALTH MINISTER

Health Ministry Director General Moshe Bar Siman-Tov suggested Friday that some restrictions on the public and economic activity could begin to be lifted after the Passover holiday in mid-April, if Israel's battle against the coronavirus pandemic is deemed to be succeeding by then.

"I really hope that if our collective efforts — those of the authorities and the people staying home — if they continue for the next two weeks and continue to bear fruit, we will be able, after Passover, to begin a return to economic activity in a measured and controlled way," he said.

His upbeat remarks came a day after National Security Adviser Meir Ben-Shabbat reportedly told cabinet ministers there are promising signs that the rate of coronavirus infections in Israel is slowing following the implementation of strict restrictions across the country.







While the directives are being stiffened,
Netanyahu said he was pleased to say that
"there are positive signs on the horizon. We
are moving forward with preparations for the
scenarios regarding the exit from the crisis.
This will happen only after the end of
Passover. But there is a real possibility that if
the positive trends in Israel continue, we will
gradually exit the lockdown after Passover."








BANS BANDS IID

HAMAS'GAZA PLAN

Leader of Hamas in Gaza Yahya Sinwar threatened Thursday that if the Gaza Strip faced a shortage of ventilators with which to treat its corona patients, Hamas would "cut off the air" to Israelis

"Let me tell [Defense Minister] Bennett, if we find that corona patients in Gaza can't breathe, we will cut off the air to six million Zionists and take what we want from you," Sinwar said in an interview to Al-Aqsa TV, which is affiliated with Hamas.

Sinwar suggested that Bennett review Chapter 17 of the *Book of Ezekiel* to see "what awaits you and your filthy entity." Ezekiel 17 prophesies doom.







COMID-19 AND HAMAS

Instead of offering to cooperate with Israel in the battle against coronavirus, Hamas is now seeking to divert attention from its failed policies by threatening to kill Jews for not helping the Palestinians in the Gaza Strip. Instead of asking for Israel's help, Hamas leaders have informed the State of Israel: "Help us or we will kill six million Jews."

And the sign flashed out its warning


In the words that it was forming

And the sign said, "The words of the


prophets are written on the subway walls

And tenement halls"


