


In case you missed Israel Defense Forces's Tweet 53 years ago, on this exact day, the Six-Day War ended after Israel came under attack from 5 Arab armies... ...Israel won.

Norway announced it will withhold funding to the PA over textbooks it says promote hate and violence.

Annexation: Palestinian and European officials hint that some countries could retaliate by recognizing a Palestinian state and sanctioning Israel.

The remains of a biblical winery believed to belong to Naboth the Jezreelite was uncovered by the Zinman Institute of Archaeology at the University of Haifa.

The IDF thwarted an Iranian cyberattack on the military's supply chain. The supply chain connects the IDF to the civilian services from which it receives gas, food, and other crucial supplies.



Times of Israel: Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu intends to apply Israeli sovereignty to three main settlement blocs of Gush Etzyon, Maale Adumim and Ariel, but not immediately to the Jordan Valley or other settlement areas.

Netanyahu reportedly feels that there is greater domestic consensus support to apply sovereignty to those blocs, and that this would create less friction with Jordan.



"Only a year ago we dreamed about sovereignty in Maale Adumim, and here we can have sovereignty over all the settlements," he said.

Netanyahu noted that contrary to the claims of the oppositionist in the Yesha Council, the main roads in Judea and Samaria will not be transferred at any stage to the Palestinians. He emphasized that there would be no construction freeze because constriction will be allowed within the communities.

Finally, Netanyahu said no Palestinians would receive Israeli citizenship within the framework of the plan. "This is a historic opportunity that comes around once every 73 years," he said.

Palestinian Prime Minister Mohammed
Shtayyeh revealed Tuesday that after years of rejecting a myriad of peace proposals, the Palestinian Authority had finally submitted its own concept for peace to the international community.

Shtayyeh said the Palestinian peace proposal will see a "sovereign Palestinian state, independent and demilitarized" that will accept "minor modifications of borders where necessary."





"The leader of Hamas in Gaza praised his rival, Palestinian leader Abbas, for cutting off ties with Israel and called for a new armed uprising against the Jewish state. "We welcome the Palestinian Authority's decision to disengage from all agreements with the Israeli occupation but we need real actions," Ismail Haniyeh. "It has been proven to all liberation movements around the world that liberation cannot be achieved unless a gun is raise!"

"It is a million times better for Israel to be responsible for the entire territory. We're ready to live under Israel's military boots rather than under the head of Abu Mazen [Mahmoud Abbas]," one person said."What has the PA done for us?" one businessman asked. "I don't want a state. I want money. Money is preferable to a state. The entire Palestinian people wants this. What does it want? It doesn't want the PA. The PA robbed us and destroyed us." "In Israel there's law and order. Life is good," said a PA policeman, adding that in the PA "all the money goes to Abu Mazen, to the PA, to those leaders." "I prefer Israeli sovereignty, a hundred percent," he said.





"Amit - they caught him! They caught him! They caught him," he said to the gravestone, telling his son he could finally sleep peacefully in his own bed.

"Thirty days I've been waiting for the phone call of redemption," Ben Yigal told Ynet. "A nightmare until they finally caught this bastard. I hope he pays the highest price, to rot in prison all his life."

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu praised the IDF and security forces "for apprehending the reprehensible murderer of the late Amit Ben Yigal. I have given the order to demolish the home of this murderer."

"Whoever tries to attack us – we will find him, sooner or later. In recent years you have seen that it is sooner," Netanyahu said.










In a recently published 250-page report, the Hong Kong-based Deep Knowledge Group ranked Israel third in the world in its list of the safest countries during the coronavirus crisis.

Israel was evaluated in addition to 199 other countries and regions, using 11,000 data points based on economic factors, lockdown policies, and other health metrics, TPS reported.

International business magazine Forbes picked up the report this week amid an uptick of cases in many countries, including Israel.

Switzerland and Germany took the top two spots.








Is hardliner Mahmoud Ahmadinejad planning a political comeback? The next Iranian presidential elections are set for May 2021. Any candidate seeking the position must first gain the approval of the powerful Guardian Council of the Constitution, an appointed and constitutionally mandated 12-member council that wields considerable power over the Islamic republic and has the final say on the identity of the candidates.


The council rejected Ahmadinejad's candidacy in 2017, but his supporters plan to make every effort to ensure approval this time around. Current President Hassan Rouhani, a moderate, is serving his second and final consecutive term. Under Iranian law, he cannot seek a third term at this time, nor has he publicly indicated he would want to do so.


