






Ireland and Norway were elected to the U.N. Security Council yesterday and Canada was denied its bid for a seat, shaping up a body likely to become even more critical of Israel in its upcoming term.

A group of Democratic House members are collecting signatures for a letter cautioning Israeli leaders against unilaterally annexing portions of the West Bank.

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has also told confidants that if Blue and White manages to torpedo government approval for sovereignty, he won't hesitate to call for another election.



A report in *Israel Hayom* this morning <u>claims</u> that Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is exploring dividing annexation efforts into two stages. The first stage would reportedly center on settlements that fall outside of the large settlement blocs, constituting about 10% of the West Bank.

Yesterday, in separate conference calls with Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell (R-KY) and key Senate and House committees, King Abdullah of Jordan <u>warned</u> that any unilateral Israeli annexation "is unacceptable and undermines the prospects of achieving peace and stability in the region."

"We are trying to educate and persuade our Jewish brothers and sisters to leave the Democratic Party, which has basically abandoned the Jews and Israel," Terris said. "JEXIT is a movement that believes that American Jews can no longer blindly vote Democrat." JEXIT says its mission is to educate Jews about the "dangerous shift" in Democrat party policy away from support of Israel.

Jews have traditionally been a bulwark of support for the Democrats, but JEXIT says the party is "undergoing a seismic and alarming change" by embracing anti-Semitic and anti-Israel comments by congressional Democrats like Ilhan Omar and Rashida Tlaib, who not only fail to defend Israel but instead support the Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions (BDS) movement.







MOSTWANTED

The US is considering withholding aid to Jordan to force Amman to extradite a woman convicted in Israel of a 2001 bombing. Ahlam Aref Ahmad Al-Tamimi, who has been living in Jordan after being freed in an Israeli prisoner swap, is on the FBI's most wanted list because two of the 15 people killed in the attack were American citizens. Reports indicate that more than 120 people were wounded and killed 15,

Jordan's King Abdullah is visiting Washington this week.





BIIMORS OF WARS

As if we didn't have enough already going on in 2020, now we are facing the possibility that several regional wars may erupt. China and India had both been pouring troops into a disputed border region, and now there has been an incident where they were actually killing each other.

On the Korean peninsula, North Korea just blew up "a joint liaison office" that it had used for talks with the South Korean government.

And in the Middle East, Turkey is warning of grave consequences if Israel goes ahead with a plan to annex portions of Judea and Samaria.

If a major regional war erupts at even one of these flash-points, it will be another devastating blow for a global economy that is already imploding, and there is a very strong probability that the U.S. and other major western powers could be drawn into the conflict.





On Monday night, one of Gaza's multiple terror groups shot a rocket at Israel, which failed to harm civilians or destroy property.

In response, IDF planes launched a counter strike, pounding positions belonging to Hamas, which has brutally ruled the coastal enclave for a decade and a half.

Israeli jets nailed underground Hamas facilities in the southern Gaza Strip.

Simultaneously, IDF tanks hammered the terror group's posts near the border.
