






A top Palestinian official has reiterated his belief that acts of terrorism constitute a legitimate response to the recent normalization deal between the Jewish state and the United Arab Emirates.

Major US Jewish groups called for Twitter to take action against the account of Ayatollah Khamenei on Tuesday, following the Iranian leader's latest antisemitic social media outburst.

Hamas' deputy chief has given Israel a two-month window in order to implement the conditions of the cease-fire reached earlier this week between the sides. Khalil al-Hayya warned that Gaza-based terrorists were prepared to enter "a confrontational campaign, even if it will lead to the bombing of Tel Aviv."



## SYRIAARSTRIKES

The Syrian Observatory for Human Rights reported Tuesday that 10 combatants were killed in airstrikes attributed to the Israel Air Force near the Syrian capital of Damascus. The organization identified the dead combatants as three Syrian government troops and seven "non-Syrian militias loyal to Hezbollah and Iranians" in attacks that targeted Lebanese Hezbollah headquarters and Iranian militias south of Damascus and in the Daraa Governate in the south of the country bordering Israel. "The raids resulted in the destruction of Lebanese Hezbollah weapons and ammunition headquarters and ammunition belonging to Lebanese Hezbollah and Iranian Revolutionary Guard," the organization said.







## SYRIAARSTRIKESII

A presumed Israeli airstrike killed 16 Iran-backed fighters in eastern Syria late Wednesday, a Syrian opposition-linked group said. Syrian state media reported that Israel conducted an attack on the T-4 air base near Palmyra at 10:23 p.m.

Wednesday, firing a number of missiles from the US-controlled al-Tanf region of eastern Syria near the Iraq border.

The Israel Defense Forces did not comment on the reported strikes, in accordance with its policy.

The reported strikes on Wednesday night came two days after Israel was said to have launched missiles at targets in Syria's south, killing at least two Syrian soldiers. A Syrian civilian woman was also reportedly killed when a Syrian military antiaircraft missile struck her home.







# SALIDIA BEDAGE

Saudi Arabia announced Wednesday that it is now allowing "all countries" to use its airspace for flights to and from the United Arab Emirates, which means an end to their boycott on flights to and from Israel flying over the Gulf state.


The state-run Saudi Press Agency issued a short press release saying that the Saudi General Authority of Civil Aviation "approved the request ... which includes the desire to allow flights coming to and departing from the United Arab Emirates to all countries to pass through the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia's airspace."

The Saudi move "will cheapen flights, it will shorten time, it will develop tremendous tourism and our economy," commented Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu.












Iranian Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei is again under fire from Jewish groups for disseminating antisemitic – if not annihilationist – rhetoric on social media. In a widely panned tweet, Khamenei denounced the recent Israel-United Arab Emirates pact "as cruelty against the interests of the World of Islam," and blamed "filthy Zionist agents of the U.S. – such as the Jewish member of Trump's family." The latter expression of hate was an apparent reference to Jared Kushner, who was instrumental in laying the groundwork for the Jerusalem-Abu Dhabi rapprochement.

Khamenei has in the past been slammed for describing Israel on Twitter as "a deadly, cancerous growth" that must be "uprooted and destroyed." Earlier this year, he shared a poster that called for a "final solution" – the term used by the Nazis for their systematic slaughter of 6 million Jews during World War II – to Israel.

Researcher says coronavirus infection rate should start dropping within weeks

A new study conducted by Ben Gurion University predicts Israel will reach a state of herd immunity against the coronavirus in the coming weeks, *Hamodia* reported Sunday.

Herd immunity occurs when a high enough percentage of the population has already contracted a disease and recovered from it, giving them enough antibodies in their systems so that the rate of new infections drops as more people gain immunity.




## END TIMES ISSUES
